U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

BEACON SECURITIES, INC., OTHERS SANCTIONED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings against Beacon Securities, Inc., Beacon Financial Group, Inc., PJM, Inc., and Patrick J. McGrath under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Section 203(e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 194, and Section 14(b) of the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order, respondents consented to the Order Making Findings that they wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933, and the antifraud, net capital, and books and records provisions of the Exchange Act. Respondents admitted that they had been permanently enjoined because of the same violations and that a trustee had been appointed, under SIPA, for Beacon Securities. Also, McGrath admitted that he had been convicted of registration and fraud violations. The Commission revoked the registrations of Beacon Securities and Beacon Financial Group as a broker-dealer and investment adviser, respectively, and barred respondents from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer. CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

CNG Trading proposes to issue and sell to Consolidated up to 500 shares of its common stock, \$1.00 par value, at \$10,000 per share.
