### CHANGE IN THE MEETING: DELETION

The following item will not be considered at the open meeting for Thursday, March 12, 1987, at 10:00 a.m.:

Consideration of whether to issue a notice of and order for hearing on an application under the Investment Company Act of 1940 (File No. 812-6393) filed by American Pathway Fund and Capital Research and Management Company. The requested order would permit shares of certain open-end management companies to be sold to separate accounts of affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies in connection with the funding of variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts. The Commission issued a notice of the filing of the above-referenced application (Release IC-15233) on July 31, 1986, and received a timely request for a hearing on the application from Anchor National Life Insurance Company and its variable annuity separate account. ### COMMENTS REQUESTED ON RULE 24f-3

The Commission is proposing for public comment Rule 24f-3 under the Investment Company Act of 1940 to simplify the way unit investment trusts pay registration fees for securities sold in the secondary market and to consolidate the information required to be filed annually by each series of a unit investment trust.

### REPROPOSAL OF COMMENTS ON FORM N-7

The Commission is reproposing for public comment Form N-7 for the registration of unit investment trusts under the Securities Act of 1933 and the Investment Company Act of 1940. Reproposed Form N-7 would integrate the reporting and disclosure requirements of the Securities Act and the Investment Company Act in one document and shorten and simplify the prospectuses used by the sponsors of unit investment trusts in the initial offering and the secondary market. The Commission is republishing staff guidelines that would assist registrants who use Form N-7. The Commission is also seeking comment on whether a delayed or continuous offering rule should be developed for unit investment trusts similar to that available to certain other issuers.

### STUDY EXPLORES REASONS FOR STOCK-PRICE RUNUPS BEFORE TAKEOVER BIDS

Rumors of impending takeovers and "foothold positions" can drive stock prices up by nearly 40% of the premium paid in tender offers prior to the announcement of a takeover bid, according to a study released today by the Commission's Office of the Chief Economist. (Press Release 87-15)

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### NASD ACTION AGAINST DAVID L. TURNIPSEED SET ASIDE; PROCEEDINGS REMANDED

The Commission set aside disciplinary action taken by the NASD against David L. Turnipseed, of Morehead, Kentucky, formerly a registered representative with two NASD member firms. The proceedings against Turnipseed were remanded to the NASD.

The NASD sanctioned Turnipseed pursuant to an offer of settlement which, at the NASD's instance, provided that it could not be withdrawn without the NASD's written consent. After nine months had elapsed without NASD acceptance of his offer, Turnipseed attempted to withdraw it. However, the NASD refused since Turnipseed had not obtained its written consent. It finally accepted Turnipseed's offer two months later.

The Commission concluded that, in sanctioning Turnipseed pursuant to his offer of settlement, the NASD had not applied its rules in a fair manner. It stated that the NASD was not entitled to bind a respondent to his offer for such a long period of time. It also noted that the NASD did not contradict Turnipseed's assertion that his determination to settle the NASD's proceeding "was based on the repeated assurances of an NASD official that settlement was the only way the matter could be quickly resolved." ### BANKERS SECURITY LIFE INSURANCE SOCIETY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bankers Security Life Insurance Society, Bankers Security Variable Annuity Funds M, P and Q, and Oppenheimer Fund Management, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of individual flexible purchase payment variable annuity contracts. ### ALLEGHENY GENERATING COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued with respect to Allegheny Generating Company (AGC), subsidiary of Allegheny Power System, Inc., releasing jurisdiction over the terms and conditions of the issuance and sale by AGC of \$100 million of debentures through a negotiated offering relating to the permanent financing of its 40% interest in the Bath County (Virginia) Pumped Storage Project. ## IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

Proposed rule changes have become effective by: The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-6) amending the Resolution of the NASD Board of Governors concerning Notice to Membership and Press of Suspensions, Exclusions, and Revocations to provide for notice of the imposition of monetary sanctions of \$10,000 or more and for a more complete description of the conduct found to constitute a rule violation.
