## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED, SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST JOHN M. CARPENTER

> The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against John M. Carpenter of Boca Raton, Florida. Carpenter was formerly employed by a New York Stock Exchange member firm at the firm's Lighthouse Point, Florida office. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement submitted by Carpenter. The Offer of Settlement consents to, and the Commission entered: (a) findings that Carpenter violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act and that a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered against him on December 9, 1986, enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws; and (b) an Order barring Carpenter from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, invsetment adviser, or investment

The Commission found that Carpenter violated the antifraud provisions by, among other things, engaging in a "ponzi scheme" under which approximately \$8 million was obtained from approximately 100 investors, and by misrepresenting to investors that funds invested would be used to purchase municipal bonds or participatory interests in a pool of municipal bonds, when the funds were actually being misappropriated and no such bonds or interests were being purchased. ## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

#### NZI CORPORATION LIMITED

An order has been issued exempting NZI Corporation Limited (NZI), a holding company, and its Delaware subsidiary, NZI Capital Corporation, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in order that they may offer and sell debt securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15606 - March 6)

#### WM LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting WM Life Insurance Company, Composite Deferred Variable Account, and Murphey Favre, Inc. exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c) (2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of individual flexible premium deferred variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-15607 - March 6)

#### HARTFORD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 31 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hartford Life Insurance Company, Hartford Life Insurance Company-Thomson McKinnon Separate Account (Account), a registered unit investment trust, and Hartford Equity Sales Company, Inc., for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the Account in connection with the issuance of certain individual and group flexible premium tax deferred variable annuity contracts. ## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until March 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24334, dated March 5: Jersey Central Power & Light Company - subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, and its subsidiary, Energy Initiatives, Incorporated (BII). BII proposes to invest in cogeneration and other projects in up to \$7 million, through December 31, 1996, and to provide certain associated services for a fee; and The Columbia Gas System, Inc. - and certain of its subsidiaries, including Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc. By order dated December 20, 1985 (Rel. 35-23921), the Columbia system companies were authorized to extend their Intercompany Financing, External Short-Term Financing, and Money Pool Program through December 31, 1987, subject to the approval of state commissions having jurisdiction over the proposed transactions. Commonwealth Services was authorized to issue, and Columbia to acquire, up to \$4 million of long-term promissory notes. Commonwealth Services now proposes, subject to approval of the State Corporation Commission of Virginia, to issue, and Columbia proposes to acquire, up to 90,000 shares of common stock (\$50 par value) and up to \$9,500,000 of long-term promissory notes for a total long-term financing program of \$14 million. Request is based upon Commonwealth Service's current estimate of capital expenditures of \$19.8 million in 1986 and 1987.
