## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

REGISTRATION OF MICHAEL DAVID MARANT DENIED

Chief Administrative Law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision denying the application of Michael David Marant, doing business as Light Investment Company, of Canon City, Colorado, for registration as an investment adviser.

Judge Blair found that Marant, who is an inmate of the Colorado Territorial Correctional Facility at Canon City serving concurrent sentences for life imprisonment for first degree murder and 12 years for conspiracy to commit first degree murder, had wilfully made untrue statements of material facts and omitted to state material facts required to be stated in the application in connection with Marant's residence, other names used by him, details concerning his criminal convictions, and his intended advisory services.

### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES NORTHSTAR MINERALS, INC.

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on March 12 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Northstar Minerals, Inc. of Houston, Texas. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Northstar, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended June 30, 1986 and its Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended September 30 and December 31, 1986, and six Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order Northstar to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Northstar Minerals, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-0687). (LR-11368)

# **CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS**

FORMER HOME STATE OFFICIALS CONVICTED

The Atlanta Regional Office, the Miami Branch Office, and Lawrence A. Kane, Jr., Special Prosecutor, announced that on March 2 a state jury sitting in Cincinnati, Hamilton County, Ohio, returned verdicts against three former Home State Savings bank officials. The jury found: (1) Marvin L. Warner, principal shareholder of Home State guilty on three counts of state securities violations and six counts of unauthorized use of Home State funds (unauthorized acts). Warner was acquitted on 35 counts of

unauthorized acts and 41 counts of willful misapplication of Home State funds; (2) Burton Bongard, of New York City, guilty of 41 counts unauthorized acts and 41 counts willful misapplication; and (3) David J. Schiebel, of Cincinnati, guilty on three counts of securities violations. Schiebel was acquitted on 41 counts each of unauthorized use and misapplication of funds and on one count of state securities violations. Sentencing is scheduled for March 30 in Cincinnati. (State of Ohio v. Marvin L. Warner, et al., Case No. B-854622, Ct. Common Pleas, Hamilton County, guilty verdicts returned March 2, 1987). (LR-11366)

VIKING TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

# **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM; CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until March 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24334, dated March 5: New England Electric System - a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to a maximum aggregate principal amount outstanding of \$100 million of short-term notes to banks, from time-to-time through December 31, 1988, by competitive bidding; and Central and South West Corporation (CSW) - a registered holding company, and five of its subsidiaries, Central Power and Light Company, Southwestern Electric Power Company, Public Service Company of Oklahoma, West Texas Utilities Company, and Transok, Inc. (collectively, operating subsidiaries), and Central and South West Services, Inc., a subsidiary, for a short-term borrowing program coordinated through the use of a money pool. Funds for the money pool would be available from surplus funds in the treasuries of the operating subsidiaries, surplus funds from the treasury of CSW, proceeds from the sale of commercial paper notes by CSW or bank borrowings by CSW or its subsidiaries. CSW requests an exception from competitive bidding for the sale of commercial paper notes.

The Commission granted accelerated approval to proposed rule changes filed by the American, New York, and Pacific Stock Exchanges and the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-Amex-87-3, SR-NYSE-87-1, SR-PSE-87-2, and SR-CBOE-87-2) to extend to May 16 the stock options pilot program providing for four expiration months, including two year term months, for the January cycle options. (Rel. 34-24193); and (SR-PSE-86-35) to amend Options Floor Procedure Advice (OFPA) B-12 to expand the number of series for which non-broker-dealer customer orders will be filled to a minimum depth of ten contracts by the market makers in the trading crowd, and to allow the provisions of OFPA B-12 to be waived in fast market conditions.
