ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST DAVID L. BUSTRUM AND TELVIN A. HAGEN

> The Commission instituted and settled administrative proceedings against David Leroy Bustrum and Telvin Arnold Hagen, formerly associated with various broker-dealers registered with the Commission. In its Order, the Commission found that on August 5, 1986, Bustrum and Hagen were permanently enjoined from violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws and from aiding and abetting violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws [SEC v. Dover Development Corporation, et al., USDC SDCA, Civil Action No. 86-4934]. The injunction was based on activities in which Bustrum and Hagen were engaged while in association with registered broker-dealers. The Commission also ordered that Bustrum and Hagen be permanently barred from associating with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company, with the right to reapply after three years in a non-proprietary, non-supervisory capacity. In antici-pation of these proceedings, Bustrum and Hagen submitted Offers of Settlement consenting to the order and sanctions, which the Commission accepted. (Rel. 34-24642)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST RUTH ELAINE BERRY

> The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 (SIPA) against Ruth Elaine Berry, former 100% shareholder and vice president of a registered brokerdealer.

> Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Berry's Offer of Settlement in which she con-sented to: (1) findings that she aided and abetted violations by a registered brokerdealer of Section 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 17a-3, 17a-4, and 17a-11, and of Section 7(c) of the Exchange Act and Regulation T by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System; (2) findings that she was the 100% shareholder of a registered broker-dealer for which a trustee was appointed under SIPA; and (3) an order suspending her from association with any broker or dealer in a supervisory or proprietary capacity for one year. The Commission issued an Order Instituting Public Proceedings, Making Findings, and Imposing Remedial Sanctions consistent with Berry's Offer of Settlement. (Rel. 34-24659)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST FP INDUSTRIES, INC., OTHERS

> The Los Angeles Regional Office filed a complaint on June 30 in the federal district court in Honolulu, Hawaii, seeking injunctive and other equitable relief against FP Industries, Inc. (FPI), a Nevada corporation headquartered in Honolulu, and several companies and persons associated with it. According to the complaint, FPI has raised at least \$33 million from more than 1,000 investors located in Hawaii and other states through sales of interests in tropical plant limited partnerships. The complaint alleges that among other material misrepresentations and omissions of material facts, investors were not told that offering proceeds were distributed to investors in earlier partnerships as returns on investments, and were not informed of the distressed financial codition of the contract grower for the partnerships. Besides FPI, the defendants are: FPI Crest Securities, Inc.; Charles E. Colburn, III; Lawrence C. Peurose; Malcolm G. Bartels; Bradley H. Koach; Agricultural Research and Technology Group, Inc.; and Richard Garcia. The complaint seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions against fraud and reporting violations. (SEC v. FP Industries, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 87-0510, ACK, D. Hawaii). (LR-11481)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERITOR MORTGAGE SECURITIES COPRORATION

An order has been issued exempting Meritor Mortgage Securities Corporation and its affiliates from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance and sale of mortgage-backed securities and equity interests. (Rel. IC-15848 - July 2)

FOGELMAN ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting Fogelman Acceptance Corporation and certain trusts it may form from all provisions of the Investment Company Act, permitting the issuance of mortgage-backed securities and equity interests in the trusts. (Rel. IC-15849 -July 2)

DREXEL BURNHAM LAMBERT MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORP.

An order amending a prior order (Release IC-15504, December 29, 1986) has been issued exempting Drexel Burnham Lambert Mortgage Acceptance Corp. and certain trusts to be created by it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance and sale of mortgage related securities and ownership interests in the trusts. (Rel. IC-15850 - July 2)

CIRFICO HOLDINGS CORPORATION

An order has been issued declaring that Cirfico Holdings Corporation has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-15851 - July 2)

SHEARSON LEHMAN CMO INC.

An order has been issued exempting Shearson Lehman CMO Inc. and certain trusts to be established by it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of mortgage-backed securities and the sale of beneficial interests in such Trusts. (Rel. IC-15852 - July 1)

FIRST BOSTON MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORP.

An order has been issued amending a prior order exempting certain trusts created by First Boston Mortgage Securities Corp. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of mortgage-backed securities. (Rel. IC-15853 - July 2)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY; OHIO POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until July 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24420, dated July 2: <u>National Fuel Gas Company</u> (National) - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation, Empire Exploration, Inc., Seneca Resources Corporation, and Utility Constructors, Inc. (UCI) for UCI to participate in the National system money pool and to establish an unsecured borrowing limit of \$1 million through December 31, 1987; and <u>Ohio Power Company</u> - subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and the coal-mining subsidiaries of Ohio Power (Subsidiaries). By orders dated June 6, 1986 and April 9, 1987 (Rel. 35-24120 and 35-24367), the Subsidiaries were authorized through June 30, 1987 to enter into leasing arrangements concerning mining equipment with an aggregate acquisition cost not exceeding \$25 million from a nonassociated company and Ohio Power was authorized to guarantee the payments of one of the Subsidiaries. Ohio Power and the Subsidiaries now propose to extend the leasing arrangements through October 1, 1987.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-PSE-87-12) to make permanent a pilot program to reduce the exposure time for orders entered through SCOREX from 30 seconds to 15 seconds. The Commission granted accelerated approval to that part of the proposal requesting extension of the pilot program until September 30, 1987 to allow the program to continue uninterrupted prior to Commission action on permanent approval of the pilot. (Rel. 34-24674)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-87-29) to provide on a pilot basis from July 31 to October 31, 1987 the NASDAQ workstation service to 90 firms. The service allows NASDAQ market makers to substitute personal computers using NASDAQ software for NASDAQ owned equipment. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of July 6. (Rel. 34-24675)
