# **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

#### PAUL ANGELACOS PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on July 20 U.S. District Court Judge Frank J. McGarr, Northern District of Illinois, vacated the judgment by default previously entered against Paul Angelacos and entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against him. Angelacos consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint. The Order enjoins Angelacos from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud and position reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 13d-1.

The April 9 complaint alleged that Angelacos and five other defendants manipulated the price of Electronics, Missiles & Communications, Inc. common stock and misrepresented to brokers their ability and intent to pay for their stock purchases. It also alleged that they failed to file a Schedule 13D after they acquired five percent or more of the oustanding stock. (SEC v. Andrew Nanos, et al., NDIL, No. 87 C 3335, filed April 9, 1987). JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST UNITED EDUCATORS, INC. AND JOSEPH KLEIN; MOTION FOR CONTEMPT AGAINST KLEIN WITHDRAWN

The Commission announced that on August 4 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia enjoined Joseph Klein, chief executive officer and chairman of the board of United Educators, Inc. (UEI) of Framinghim, Massachusetts, from violating books and records provisions of the securities laws. On July 31, the Court enjoined UEI from violating the reporting and books and records provisions of the securities laws. UEI and Klein consented to the Judgments of Permanent Injunction.

The Commission also withdrew a motion to adjudge Klein in civil contempt for violation of a 1982 injunction relating to another issuer. That injunction prohibited Klein from causing any issuer to fail to file timely periodic reports. In its contempt motion, the Commission alleged that Klein caused UEI to fail to file complete Annual Reports for 1985 and 1986, and to fail to file three Quarterly Reports for 1986 and its quarter ended March 31. The Commission withdrew the motion as moot after UEI filed its delinquent reports on July 29. (SEC v. United Educators, Inc. and Joseph Klein, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-1840-HHG and SEC v. Cavanagh Communities Corporation and Joseph Klein, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 82-2415-HHG). (LR-11505)
