CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST ROBERT A. DIIANNI GRANTED

The Boston Regional Office announced that on August 5 Judge A. David Mazzone, U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts, granted the Commission's motion for a preliminary injunction against Robert A. Dilanni of Boston freezing assets and restraining him from receiving, controlling, or possessing funds or securities of any person who invested with, or through, Dilanni. The order directs Dilanni to produce an accounting of investors' funds held by certain entities previously identified by Dilanni to the Commission. The order further enjoins defendant from further violations of the securities laws. Dilanni's activities were brought to the Commission's attention by investor complaints and a referral from the Boston Office of the National Association of Securities Dealers. (SEC v. Robert A. Dilanni, Civil Action No. 87-1891-MA, DCMA). (LR-11512)
