COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED REVISIONS TO FORM N-1A

The Commission is proposing for public comment revisions to Form N-1A that would consolidate expense disclosure in a tabular form at the front of each mutual fund prospectus. The proposed table would reflect the one-time fees paid directly by the shareholder, the recurring expenses paid from fund assets or deducted from shareholder accounts, and the effect of these fees on a hypothetical investment.

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

► PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST DE LAURENTIIS ENTERTAINMENT GROUP, INC.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against De Laurentiis Entertainment Group, Inc. (DEG). Simultaneous with the institution of proceedings, DEG submitted an Offer of Settlement, which the Commission accepted for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by these proceedings. DEG, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to the Order Instituting Proceedings, the Opinion, Findings, and Order of the Commission, and agreed to undertakings.

The Commission found that DEG violated Sections 13(b)(2)(A) and (B) of the Exchange Act respecting its allocation of interest costs and selling general and administrative costs in that it failed to make and keep adequate books and records and failed to devise and maintain adequate internal controls. The Commission ordered DEG to comply with Section 13(b)(2) of the Exchange Act and its undertakings, in which DEG agreed to: (1) keep records and maintain internal controls sufficient to comply with Section 13(b)(2); (2) prepare, in conjunction with independent auditors, and use a written statement of accounting policies and procedures for capitalizing and expensing its interest and selling general and administrative costs; and (3) submit that written statement to the Commission.
