CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST WALLACE C. SPARKMAN, OTHERS

The Fort Worth Regional and Houston Branch Offices filed an action on August 31 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas against Wallace C. Sparkman, Steven G. Herbst, and Kenneth B. Holmes, all of Corpus Christi, Texas, alleging violations of the antifraud, reporting, books and records, and proxy provisions of the securities laws. Simultaneously and without admitting or denying the allegations, defendants consented to orders of permanent injunction; and Sparkman further consented to an order barring him from serving as, or performing the duties of, either an officer or director of any publicly-held company for four years.

The Complaint alleges that from late 1980 to late 1984, Sparkman, and certain companies under his control, received through Hutson Management Services (HMS) approximately \$1 million in connection with a kickback scheme he orchestrated while serving as an officer and director of Sparkman Energy Corporation (SPM). According to the Complaint, Herbst, Holmes, and another third party, as part of an undisclosed arrangement with Sparkman, made payments to HMS from the commissions they received on certain contracts negotiated on behalf of SPM. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

MICHAEL W. STRAND AND GALEN J. ROSS SENTENCED

The U.S. Attorney for the District of Wyoming and the Atlanta Regional Office announced that on August 26 U.S. District Judge Alan B. Johnson, District of Wyoming, sentenced Michael W. Strand of Bountiful, Utah, to seven years in a federal prison, \$150,000 in fines, and probation for an additional five years after the seven-year prison term is served. Galen J. Ross of Salt Lake City, Utah, was sentenced to five years probation and ordered to pay a fine of \$10,000. Strand and Ross were convicted on May 28, after a four-week trial, by a jury in Casper, Wyoming, of conspiracy and mail fraud.

The indictment alleged, among other things, that defendants fraudulently induced investors to purchase more than \$7 million in limited partnership interests in oil and gas wells and a gas gathering pipeline, as well as the common stock of Classic Mining Corporation and Living Industries, Inc. (U.S. v. A. Leonard Varah, et al., USDC WY, CR-86-0063-J). (LR-11531)
