CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST HUGH F. SACKETT

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on September 17 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of California entered a Final Judgment permanently enjoining Hugh F. Sackett from violating the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Sackett consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The September 3, 1986 complaint alleged that from 1979 through at least March 1984, Sackett and W. Carl Zimmerman directed and controlled the offer and sale of unregistered securities of American Principals Holdings Inc. (APHI) in the form of limited partnership interests and debentures in approximately 70 offerings which raised in excess of \$90 million from at least 2,500 investors. The complaint further alleged that Sackett and Zimmerman caused APHI to make material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the actual use of investors' funds, in that, among other things: approximately \$10 million of investors' funds were loaned between certain limited partnerships and the APHI general partners; and investors' funds were commingled among partnerships. (SEC v. W. Carl Zimmerman and Hugh F. Sackett, USDC SDCA, Civil Action Action No. 86-1846 N, CM). (LR-11545)

COMPLAINT FILED AGAINST HENRY H. MCFLIKER, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint on September 2 in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Missouri against Henry H. McFliker, Bruce C. Wright, and James W. Wilkinson in connection with activity involving Universal Money Centers, Inc., a public company located in Shawnee Mission, Kansas. The complaint alleges that McFliker, a Florida resident and formerly the chief executive officer and a director of Universal, violated the antifraud, registration, and certain reporting and books and records provisions of the securities laws. It further alleges that Wilkinson and Wright, Oklahoma residents and former directors of Universal, also violated certain of these provisions. It also charges McFliker and Wright with failure to file security ownership reports on Forms 3 and 4 in a timely manner. On September 15, Judge Stevens entered permanent injunctions against McFliker and Wilkinson who consented to the Orders without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. (SEC v. Henry H. McFliker, et al., WDMO, W. Div., Civil Action No. 87-0777-CV-W8). (LR-11547)
