PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST MYRON K. BERRYMAN

Sec news

The Commission simultaneously instituted administrative proceedings and imposed sanctions under Rule 2(e) of its Rules of Practice against Myron K. Berryman, a certified public accountant, of Salt Lake City, Utah. The action was taken pursuant to an Offer of Settlement from Berryman. The Commission found in its Order that Berryman engaged in improper professional conduct by failing to follow generally accepted auditing standards in connection with audited financial statements prepared for 18 Utah blank check/blind pool offerings whose S-18 Registration Statements or Regulation A Offering Statements were filed with the Commission. He failed to: disclose a material related party in the financial statements; secure a bank confirmation directly from the bank; secure a management representation letter; and perform a subsequent events review.

The Commission's Order denies Berryman the privilege of appearing and practicing before it; however, it provides that after two years, he may apply to resume practice upon a showing that he has complied with certain specified requirements, including professional peer review and training. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES KENNETH S. SHASHOUA

The New York Regional Office filed a Complaint on September 30 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Kenneth S. Shashoua, a registered representative formerly associated with Rooney, Pace Inc., a registered broker-dealer.

The Complaint alleges that from September through December 1986, Shashoua abused his discretionary authority over customers' brokerage accounts by forging their signatures to letters which enabled him to make transfers of funds and securities from customers' accounts to his own accounts. According to the Complaint, Shashoua concealed his activities by intercepting his customers' confirmations and account statements and creating false account statements which he sent to his customers. The Complaint alleges that Shashoua converted over \$1.6 million worth of funds and securities to his own use by this scheme, thereby violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

Simultaneous with the filing of the Complaint, Shashoua, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to a permanent injunction prohibiting further violations of the securities laws described above. (SEC v. Kenneth S. Shashoua, USDC SDNY, 87 Civ. 7012). (LR-11570)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PACIFIC SELECT FUND

An order has been issued granting Pacific Select Fund exemptions from Sections 13(a)(2), 18(f)(1), 22(f), and 22(g) of the Investment Company Act and approving certain transactions to permit the Fund to implement a deferred compensation plan for its trustees. (Rel. IC-16019 - Sept. 30) A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by Shearson Lehman Special Income Portfolios for an order amending an existing order (Rel. IC-14706, September 5, 1985) to permit the waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge in certain circumstances. (Rel. IC-16020 - Sept. 30)

COMPAGNIE FINANCIERE DE SUEZ

An order has been issued exempting Compagnie Financiere De Suez from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with its issuance of debt and equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-16023 - Oct. 1)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: <u>The National Association of</u> <u>Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-20) to permit it to operate its pilot program for the</u> <u>exchange of quotation information between the NASD and the International Stock</u> <u>Exchange, London, England. The pilot program will operate for a two-year period.</u> (Rel. 34-24979); and <u>The Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Phix-86-36) to adopt on a permanent basis its program allowing the use of letters of credit to satisfy foreign currency option customer margin requirements.
