U.S. SHOURTER D EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST GORDON SARGENT

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Gordon Sargent, a registered representative formerly associated with G.C. George Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer located in Spokane, Washington. Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Sargent consented to the sanctions imposed by the Commission.

The Order finds that Sargent wilfully violated Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and its Rule 10b-5, in connection with the promotion and sale of common stock of a British Columbia corporation, Golden Bear Resources, Ltd. The stock formerly traded on the Vancouver Stock Exchange and was not registered with the Commission. Sargent disseminated false and misleading information about Golden Bear and failed to disclose material information. The Commission suspended Sargent from association with any broker or dealer for 90 days. (Rel. 34-24945)

OPINION AND ORDER ISSUED AGAINST RICHARD S. GILMAN AND DIANE MARTANO VAN SON

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings and Opinion and Order under Rule 2(e) of its Rules of Practice against Richard S. Gilman and Diane Martano Van Son, certified public accountants who were formerly a partner and staff accountant, respectively, of Fox and Company. The Order denies Gilman and Van Son the privilege of practicing before the Commission, but allows them to apply to resume after twelve and nine months, respectively, upon a showing of satisfaction of specified educational and professional association requirements. Gilman and Van Son consented to the Order without admitting or denying the findings therein.

The Order finds that Gilman and Van Son engaged in improper professional conduct in that they conducted deficient audits of the 1981 and 1982 financial statements of International Teldata Corporation. The statements were included in filings made by Teldata under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. According to the Order, Gilman and Van Son failed to properly audit related party transactions, placed undue reliance on management representations, and failed to obtain competent evidential matter to afford a reasonable basis for Fox and Company's unqualified opinions. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BENJAMIN FRANKLIN FINANCIAL CORPORATION

An order has been issued on an application filed by Benjamin Franklin Financial Corporation amending a previous order issued to Applicant (Rel. IC-15847, July 2, 1987) which conditionally exempted Applicant from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of mortgage-backed securities. The amended order will permit Applicant to sell its capital stock, issue variable rate bonds, and to elect REMIC status. (Rel. IC-16033 - Oct. 5)

PROVIDENTMUTUAL VARIABLE LIFE MONEY MARKET ACCOUNT; PROVIDENTMUTUAL VARIABLE LIFE BOND ACCOUNT; SHORT-TERM YIELD SECURITIES, INC.; THOMSON MCKINNON GLOBAL TRUST

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 2 to request a hearing on an application by Providentmutual Variable Life Money Market Account, Providentmutual Variable Life Bond Account, Short-Term Yield Securities, Inc., and Thomson McKinnon Global Trust for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-16034; IC-16035; IC-16036; IC-16038 - Oct. 6)

An order has been issued declaring Valley Opportunities Incorporated to be primarily engaged in a business other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding, or trading securities or, alternatively, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act and the rules thereunder (with certain exemptions). HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until October 26 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24469, dated October 1: The Southern Company - a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Southern Electric International, Inc. (SEI), to extend through December 31, 1992, the period during which SEI, under to an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50, may issue and sell its long-term unsecured promissory notes in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$75 million at any one time outstanding, and Southern may acquire and/or guarantee some of all of the notes, as authorized by order dated November 18, 1985 [Rel. 35-23911].

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed amended rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-86-22) that amends Subsections 5(e) and (f) of Appendix F to Article III, Section 34 of its Rules of Fair Practice [the original proposed rule change was filed on August 5, 1986 and published in the Federal Register, 51 FR 29729, on August 20, 1986]. The amended rule change prohibits members and associated persons from directly or indirectly accepting non-cash compensation from sponsors of direct participation programs, affiliates of sponsors, or programs themselves (outside sponsors), but permits members to provide non-cash compensation to their associates in connection with in-house incentive programs. It prohibits outside sponsors, including affiliates of members, from directly or indirectly participating in or contributing to, providing this in-house non-cash compensation. Finally, it provides that cash compensation paid by outside sponsors to members may not be directly or indirectly related to in-house non-cash compensation provided by members to their associates.

Publication of the proposed amended rule change is expected to be made in the <u>Federal</u> Register during the week of October 12. (Rel. 34-24995)

AFPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-23) to update certain of its membership rules. (Rel. 34-24996)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Citicorp that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four existing, previously indentures and under a Pooling and Servicing Agreement dated June 1, 1987 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, are not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disgualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee under any of indentures or the Agreement.
