ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RULE 2(e) PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST STEPHEN GROSSMAN

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Proceedings and Opinion and Order under Rule 2(e) of its Rules of Practice against Stephen Grossman, a certified public accountant licensed in Pennsylvania.

The Order finds that Grossman has been permanently enjoined by a consent judgment from violating or aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud, periodic reporting, and Foreign Corrupt Practice Act provisions of the securities laws. The injunctive action against Grossman and three other individuals alleged an extensive financial fraud relating to the initial public offering of Computer Input Services, Inc. (CISI) in April 1982, and subsequent public filings with the Commission. Grossman was an accountant to CISI during the time of the alleged violations.

The Opinion and Order permanently denies Grossman the privilege of appearing or practicing before the Commission. After five years, Grossman may apply to resume appearing or practicing before the Commission as a preparer or reviewer, or person responsible for the preparation or review, of financial statements of a public company, or alternatively as an auditor, upon a proper showing that he has met certain conditions set forth in the Order. Grossman submitted an Offer of Settlement, consenting to the Order without admitting or denying the findings therein. (Rel. 34-25133; AAER-172)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

THOMAS C. SHIU PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on November 3 U.S. District Judge William T. Hart, Northern District of Illinois, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against Thomas C. Shiu, also known as Thomas Moy. Shiu was subject to a Temporary Restraining Order entered on September 4. The Order, among other things, enjoins Shiu from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Order directs Shiu to disgorge certain assets and funds, including \$46,000 derived from the sale of a boat. He consented to the Order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's Complaint.

The Commission alleged that Shiu, in connection with the offer and sale of unregistered securities, misstated and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the authority to effect securities transactions, the risk of the investment, the use of investor funds, and the fabrication of account statements. COURT ISSUES WARRANT FOR THE ARREST OF EMIL LEINER

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on November 4 U.S. District Judge Brian Barnett Duff, Northern District of Illinois, ordered that a warrant be issued for the arrest of Bmil Leiner. The Court further ordered that Leiner be imprisoned until he testifies and produces the documents required by the Commission's three subpoenas <u>duces tecum</u> or demonstrates his inability to do so. The Court had previously ordered, on June 4, that Leiner appear, testify, and produce the documents required by the subpoenas <u>duces tecum</u>. Leiner failed to do so, and on July 29 the Court found him in civil contempt of its June 4 Order and fined him \$250 a day until he testified and produced the subpoenaed documents or until he established that his medical condition prevented him from doing so. Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by DQU Funding Corporation; CTC Beaver Valley Funding Corporation; and BVPS Funding Corporation for an order exempting them from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with their issuance of bonds to facilitate Duquesne Light Company, by DQU; The Toledo Edison Company and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, by CTC; and Ohio Edison Company, by BVPS; in certain leveraged lease transactions.
