EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DONALD E. EHRLICH SUSPENDED; PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST GALLAGHER & CO., OTHERS

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Gallagher & Co., Russell K. Gallagher, and Laura K. Gallagher, a broker-dealer and its principals located in Weat Palm Beach, Florida, and Donald E. Ehrlich, a registered representative with Greenfield Campbell located in San Diego, California.

The Order alleges that Respondents violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by engaging in a scheme designed to make it appear that a "part or none" securities offering was sold such that the offering could close. The Order also alleges that Respondents were permanently enjoined from engaging in the above-described viola-

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement in which Ehrlich consented to an Order which makes findings and suspends him for four months from association with any broker, dealer, and others, and further provides that for three and one-half years following his suspension he shall not be associated with any such entity other than in a non-supervisory, non-proprietary capacity. YEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED; CONNECTICUT YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY
