COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION NAMES LAWRENCE IASON AS REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR OF ITS NEW YORK REGIONAL OFFICE

Chairman David S. Ruder yesterday announced the selection of Lawrence Iason as the Regional Administrator of the Commission's New York Regional Office. Mr. Iason will join the staff toward the end of January, 1988. In announcing the appointment, Chairman Ruder said, "Mr. Iason brings to the Commission 16 years of law practice experience in both civil and criminal matters. He has been a public-sector prosecutor and private-sector defense attorney and has particular expertise in the federal securities laws. The depth and breadth of his background made him the outstanding applicant in an excellent group of candidates for the position of Regional Administrator in New York. I am confident that Larry will continue the Commission's vigorous enforcement and administrative policies." (Press Release 87-92)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RESERVE BANK ACCOUNT PROCEEDING INSTITUTED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Underwood, Neuhaus & Co., Incorporated, a Houston-based broker-dealer, and two individuals. The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that during 1985 Underwood wilfully violated the hypothecation prohibitions and customer protec-tion requirements of the securities laws. The individuals, George Donehoo, is said to have been the firm's Operations Manager, and William Merritt, is said to have been the firm's Assistant Operations Manager, during the pertinent period.

In particular, the Order alleges that, on six occasions during the summer of 1985, Underwood paid down certain loans secured by customer securities for the one day only as of which it was required to compute its reserve bank account requirements and was therefore under-deposited on those days by amounts averaging \$3 million. Additionally, the firm is alleged also on six occasions to have pledged certain customer securities, commingled with the firm's own securities under liens for loans to the firm. The average amounts of customer securities thereby hypothecated is alleged to have been \$6 million.

A hearing will be held to determine whether these charges are true and, if so, to determine what remedial action, if any, should be taken. (Rel. 34-25200)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST BRUCE C. WRIGHT

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on December 14 Judge Joseph Stephens, Western District of Missouri, entered a permanent injunction against Bruce C. Wright, of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, enjoining him from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b), and 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 13a-1, and 13a-13. Wright consented to the order.

The September 2 Complaint alleged that Wright aided and abetted defendants Henry McFlicker's and James Wilkinson's violations in connection with a transaction purportedly involving the sale by Universal Money Centers, Inc. of numerous automatic teller machines (ATM). Wright was a director of Universal from October 1981 through January 1983. According to the Complaint, Wright's conduct caused Universal to improperly record this transaction in its books and records and materially overstate its revenues for the year ending January 31, 1983 and materially understate its

liabilities for the year ending January 31, 1984, the reports of which were included in Universal's Forms 10-K and 10-Q filed in 1983 and 1984. The Complaint also alleged that Wright failed to file Forms 3 and 4 reflecting his initial ownership of and subsequent trading in Universal common stock. On September 15 Judge Stephens, by consent, entered permanent injunctions against McFlicker and Wilkinson. (SEC v. Henry H. McFlicker, et al., WDMO, W. Div., Civil Action No. 87-0777-CV-W8). A conditional order has been issued permanently exempting David Lerner Associates, Inc., Spirit of America Management Corp., and David Lerner from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act to allow them to serve or act in certain capacities for Spirit of America Government Fund, Inc., an open-end, diversified, management investment company. JERSEY CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY; COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY
