DECISION IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

HERBERT L. WITTOW, JOHN F. COUGHENOUR SANCTIONED. The Commission has issued an opinion in which it found that Herbert L. Wittow, doing business as Wittow & Company, and John F. Coughenour, both of Denver, Colo., had wiclated provisions of the Federal securities acts in connection with unrelated transactions in stock of Worldwide Energy Company, Ltd., and imposed suspensions on them of 14 days and 7 days, respectively.

Wittow's transactions were effected pursuant to a customer's order to sell Worldwide shares as agent and at specified prices or better. The Commission found that in executing the order, however, Wittow sold at prices which were below prevailing market prices, and that he thereby participated, together with snother broker-dealer with whom the underpriced sale procedures were arranged and carried out, in a fraudulent scheme in violation of the antifraud provisions.

Coughenour, the Commission found, sold unregistered shares of Worldwide for a person who had acquired a block of such shares as partial consideration for his sale of properties to a corporation which controlled Worldwide and was under a common control with it, and who was therefore a statutory underwriter of the shares. According to the opinion, Coughenour did not make reasonable inquiry into the facts relating to the saleability of the shares without registration, and his transactions were violative of Section 5 of the Securities Act. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

SEC CITES VERNON LEROY GRAY; MAXEL V. GRAY. The Commission has ordered administrative proceedings against Vernon Leroy Gray and Maxel V. Gray of Midland, Mich. The proceedings are based on staff allegations that the respondents committed violations of the anti-fraud provisions of the Federal securities laws.

A public hearing will be scheduled by further order to afford respondents an opportunity to refute the staff's allegations and to establish any defenses, and to determine, what, if any, remedial action is appropriate in the public interest.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASE

PAN AMERICAN SULPRUE. The SEC has issued a notice under the Investment Company Act giving interested persons until September 3 to request a hearing upon an application of Pan American Sulphur Company, Alexandria, Va., for an order extending the period from 60 to 80 days within which a meeting of holders of its outstanding voting securities must be held to elect directors of Pan American pursuant to provisions of the Act as a result of the fact that a majority of the directors of Pan American now holding office were not elected by holders of its outstanding voting securities. 1/(Release IC-6696)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASE

INDIANA & MICHIGAN ELECTRIC. The SEC has issued an order under the Holding Company Act upon an application of Indiana & Michigan Electric Company (I&M), Fort Wayne, Ind. subsisidary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and its newly-organized Bridgman, Mich. subsidiary, Indiana & Michigan Power Company (I&M Power), with respect to a financing program for I&M Power. I&M Power was organized to own and operate the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Generating Plant, which I&M is presently constructing at Bridgman, Mich. This order among other things, now authorize that I&M Power to issue and sell from time to time up to \$200 million of notes to banks to mature in 1977, I&M make up to \$130 million of capital contribucions to I&M Power and I&M Power to make available to I&M all of the power available at the Donald C. Cook Plant and I&M Power amounts sufficient for I&M Power to pay operating and certain expenses. (Release 35-17247)
