AMENDMENT TO RULES OF PRACTICE RE DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY ADOPTED

The Commission adopted an amendment to its Rules of Practice that delegates to the Director of the Division of Market Regulation authority to determine, and issue orders regarding, whether proposals for futures trading on an index or group of securities meet the standards set forth under Section 2(a)(i)(B)(ii) of the Commodity Exchange Act. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

Chairman Shad will testify before the Oversight and Investigations Committee of the House of Representatives on July 19 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 2123, Rayburn. Subject of the testimony is accounting issues in regard to savings and loan institutions.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST FRANK CARLONE, OTHERS

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against Frank Carlone, Robert Lyons, Lawrence Adelman and John Jacob regarding an alleged scheme involving forgeries, misappropriation of funds and falsification of records. Carlone and Lyons were registered representatives employed by a registered broker-dealer in its Pepper Pike, Ohio branch office; Adelman was the branch manager of that office. Jacob was a registered representative at the Cleveland, Ohio branch office of the same broker-dealer.

The Order for Proceedings alleges: violations of the antifraud provisions by Carlone, Jacob and Lyons; that Carlone and Lyons were convicted of crimes which subjects them to being sanctioned under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; and that Adelman failed to supervise Carlone, Lyons and another salesman.

The Commission simultaneously accepted Offers of Settlement from Jacob, Lyons and Adelman in which they, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to findings as set forth in the Orders.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the allegations against Carlone. (Rel. 34-22211; 34-22212)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

UNIVERSAL ENERGY CORPORATION ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on July 10 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Universal Energy Corporation of Tulsa, Oklahoma. The Judgment restrained and enjoined Universal from failing to file timely periodic reports and Notifications of Late Filing.

In its June 11 complaint, the Commission alleged that Universal, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended October 31, 1984, and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended January 31, 1985. Universal, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it had failed to file or filed late eight Annual and Quarterly Reports on Forms 10-K and 10-Q and six Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25. (SEC v. Universal Energy Corporation, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-1900). (LR-10821)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

OMEGA VENTURE PARTNERS I LTD.;
OMEGA GOVERNMENT FUND, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until August 5 to request a hearing on an application by Omega Venture Partners I Ltd. and Omega Government Fund, Inc. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be an investment companies. (Rel. IC-14628; IC-14629 - July 12)

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 26 to comment on the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-22227)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-10) which provides that stop and stop limit orders in the Standard and Poors 100 Index become effective when either a transaction has occurred at the stop price or the market quotation on the same side of the market equals the price on the order. (Rel. 34-22223)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-29) which provides that exchange approved Treasury notes, other than Treasury notes which underlie an exchange-traded Treasury note option, may collateralize a Treasury security escrow receipt. (Rel. 34-22228)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-15) to amend its rules to provide a uniform, premium-based customer margin system for "short" options positions. (Rel. 34-22235); (SR-NASD-85-17) to improve the operation of the Intermarket Trading System by encouraging the prompt and equitable resolution of locked and crossed markets. (Rel. 34-22237); and The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-85-9) that would enable OCC to issue, clear and settle "European style" options. European style options can be exercised only on their expiration date. (Rel. 34-22236)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 15.

JOHN HANCOCK VENTURE CAPITAL MANAGEMENT, INC.

An order has been issued exempting John Hancock Venture Capital Management, Inc. from the provisions of Section 205(1) of the Investment Advisers Act to permit performance fees based on the profits and losses of certain limited partnerships, and Rule 204-2 (b) and (c) to the extent those provisions would require separate records to be maintained for each limited partner in the limited partnerships. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
