CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

ACTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF FILED AGAINST WESLEY A. CALDWELL, JR.

The Commission today filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking injunctive relief against Wesley A. Caldwell, Jr., of Brandon, Mississippi. In its complaint, the Commission alleged that Caldwell violated or aided and abetted the violation of antifraud, periodic reporting, recordkeeping-internal controls, proxy soliciting and ownership reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Commission alleged that, over a period of years while President of Magna Corporation of Flowood, Mississippi, Caldwell obtained significant advances and other benefits from Magna, without review and approval, and caused Magna to improperly record such transactions and to issue reports and proxy statements in which such transactions were not disclosed or were inadequately disclosed. Caldwell consented to a proposed Final Judgment without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. (SEC v. Wesley A. Caldwell, Jr., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-2446). (LR-10839)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to acquire up to \$2 million of notes issued by customers for financing certain conservation measures during the period ending December 31, 1989. (Rel. 35-23773 - July 30)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 26 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to enter into indemnity, liability and guarantee agreements in connection with the Southern Company Services, Inc. acting as transfer agent and registrar of Southern's common stock. MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Middle South Energy, Inc. (MSE), Mississippi Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Arkansas Power & Light Company, and New Orleans Public Service Inc., for MSE to amend the Letter of Credit and Reimbursement Agreement, dated December 1, 1984, to provide cash collateral to the Letter of Credit Banks after their loans under the Second Amended and Restated Bank Loan Agreement have been paid. The security interest in the cash collateral granted to the holders of the Series C Pollution Control Bonds will be governed by a Security Agreement. MSE also proposes to increase the per annum commission to the Letter of Credit Banks under the Reimbursement Agreement. (Rel. 35-23775 - July 30)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-23) to amend exchange rules relating to facilitation orders. (Rel. 34-22273)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-85-32) to make permanent its pilot program for the retail automatic execution system in OEX orders, with certain modifications. (Rel. 34-22274); (SR-CBOE-85-33) to extend to November 8, 1985 its Retail Automatic Execution System for certain orders in Standard and Poor's 100 Index options. (Rel. 34-22275); and The National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-85-7) to establish the Automated Customer Account Transfer Service (ACAT) which would enable NSCC members to effect automated transfers of customer accounts among themselves. ACAT is designed to complement a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) that requires NYSE members to use automated clearing agency customer account transfer services and to effect customer account transfers within specified time frames. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
