

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST HAMPSTEAD ENERGY INTERNATIONAL, INC. AND MARK JOSEPH SCHAFER

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on October 23 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Hampstead Energy International, Inc., a Canadian corporation, and Mark Joseph Schafer, of Quebec, Canada, temporarily restraining them from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The complaint, which seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions and an accounting, alleged that from July 1984 through the present, Schafer offered and sold securities in the form of general partnership interests in oil and gas drilling ventures through Hampstead and through Energy Research Group, a defunct entity which, until February 1985, was located in Coronado, California.

In connection with the offers and sales of these securities, the complaint alleges that Schafer misrepresented and omitted to state material facts concerning the use of proceeds, the returns on investment, and the cost of drilling the wells. Schafer had previously been sanctioned by the State of Iowa and the Quebec Securities Commission for the offer and sale of unregistered securities. The complaint alleged that in excess of \$800,000 was raised from approximately 125 investors. (SEC v. Hampstead Energy International, Inc. and Mark Joseph Schafer, NDIL, Civil Action No. 85C 20314, filed October 23, 1985). (LR-10922)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JAMES LAIACONA

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on October 21 U.S. District Judge Jose Gonzalez, Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against James Laiacona of Boca Raton, Florida. Laiacona was the president of R.H. Stewart & Co., Inc. (Stewart), a broker-dealer with its principal office in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The Final Judgment enjoins Laiacona from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Final Judgment further enjoins Laiacona from aiding and abetting violations of the net capital, bookkeeping and customer protection provisions of the Exchange Act.

Laiacona consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations. The complaint alleged violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by Stewart and Laiacona and violations of the net capital, bookkeeping and customer protection provisions by Stewart, aided and abetted by Laiacona. On September 30, a trustee was appointed for Stewart under the provisions of the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970. (SEC v. R.H. Stewart & Co., Inc. and James Laiacona, SDFL, Civil Action No. 85-6756-CIV-GONZALEZ). (LR-10923)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to finance pollution control facilities in an amount not to exceed \$100 million. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the issuance and sale of up to \$50 million of additional preferred stock. (Rel. 35-23890 - Nov. 1)

COLUMBUS AND SOUTHERN ELECTRIC COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 26 to request a hearing on a proposal by Columbus and Southern Ohio Electric Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, to finance certain pollution control facilities in an amount up to \$125 million. (Rel. 35-23891 - Nov. 1)

An order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, West Texas Utilities Company (WTU), to extend until June 30, 1986 the authority for WTU to issue up to 300,000 additional shares of its preferred stock, \$100 par value per share. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
