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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

FIRST MONMOUTH SECURITIES CORPORATION AND EUGENE B. GULKA CITED

The Commission announced that in public administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, First Monmouth Securities Corporation (Registrant) and Eugene B. Gulka submitted an Offer of Settlement, which the Commission accepted. Registrant and Gulka consented to Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Order for Public Proceedings.

The Order finds that Registrant wilfully violated, and Gulka wilfully aided and abetted violations of, the amendment to application, hypothecation of customer securities, customer protection, bookkeeping, financial reporting and lost and stolen securities provisions of the Exchange Act.

The Order censures Registrant and Gulka and requires Registrant's compliance with undertakings to institute compliance procedures. (Rel. 34-22704)

APPEAL OF STEVEN TELSEY FROM NASD ACTION DISMISSED AS MOOT

The Commission dismissed as moot an appeal by Steven Telsey, who is subject to certain statutory disqualifications, from the NASD's refusal to permit his employment by Citiwide Securities Corporation. The Commission noted that Telsey had abandoned his effort to become associated with Citiwide, and that his application to become associated with another firm is now pending before the NASD. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DREXEL BURNHAM LAMBERT, INCORPORATED

A notice and order of temporary exemption has been issued giving interested persons until January 17, 1986 to request a hearing on an application filed by Drexel Burnham Lambert, Incorporated under Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940. The application requests a permanent exemption from the prohibitions of Section 9(a) of the Act operative as a result of an injunction against Drexel and an affiliated person in SEC v. Drexel Burnham Lambert, Incorporated and Stanley S. Trotman, Jr. (Rel. IC-14862 - Dec. 20)

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE MUTUAL FUNDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 14, 1986 to request a hearing on an application for an order permitting offers of exchange among existing and any future Prudential-Bache Mutual Funds and for an exemption from Section 22(d) of the Investment Company Act to allow variation, deferral or waiver of contingent deferred sales loads in such exchanges. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries to extend its Intercompany Financing, External Short-Term Financing and Money Pool Program through December 31, 1987. (Rel. 35-23957 - Dec. 20)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company (National), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Penn-York Energy Corporation, Seneca Resources Corporation and Empire Exploration, Inc., to enter into intra-system borrowing arrangements through a system money pool for the years 1986-1987. Distribution, Supply, Seneca, Penn-York and Empire propose to borrow \$150, \$125, \$140, \$20 and \$20, respectively. National is authorized to issue and sell from January 1, 1986 through December 31, 1987 up to \$80 million aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time of its commercial paper and notes to banks under external short-term lines of credit. The commercial paper and short-term bank borrowings would not exceed an aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time of the amount allowable under National's Restated Certificate, which equalled \$355,675,000 as of August 31, 1985. MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$71.5 million of its unsecured promissory notes to a group of commercial banks under a revolving credit agreement. This proposal was noticed by the Commission on November 26, 1985 [Rel. 35-23923]. (Rel. 35-23959 - Dec. 23)

KINGSPORT POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 16, 1986 to request a hearing on a proposal by Kingsport Power Company, Michigan Power Company, Ohio Valley Electric Corporation and Wheeling Electric Company, subsidiaries of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to issue up to \$10 million aggregate principal amount by each of unsecured promissory notes in connection with borrowings from one or more commercial banks, under a proposed Term Loan Agreement, for not less than two nor more than ten years. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on a temporary basis, a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-35) relating to modification of the facilities description of the Computer Assisted Execution System. (Rel. 34-22735)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSE-85-11) to amend its rules regarding the use of Midwest's Automatic Execution System (MAX) in order to facilitate the routing and execution of transactions in a portfolio of equity securities. Among other changes, the time frame between the time a market order is entered into MAX and the time it is automatically executed will be reduced from 15 seconds to 0 seconds.

Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of December 23. (Rel. 34-22734)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

GENERAL FOODS CORPORATION

An order has been issued on the application filed by General Foods Corporation under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Citibank, N.A. of four indentures qualified under the Act and an indenture exempt under the Act is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Citibank from acting as trustee under any of such indentures.
