SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration Jones Plumbing Systems, Inc., Common Stock, 20¢ Par Value. (Rel. 34-36820)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-96-02) relating to voting of proxies by its member firms for holders of auction rate preferred securities. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 12. (Rel. 34-36813)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Options Price Reporting Authority filed pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 an amendment to its National Market System Plan (SR-OPRA-96-1) for the purpose of revising the information fees payable by professional subscribers to last sale and quotation information. Publication of the Release in the Federal Register is expected during the week of February 12. (Rel. 34-36817)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-95-14) filed by The Options Clearing Corporation under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposed rule change modifies the cut-off times for the filing of late exercise notices for any eligible option contracts and eliminates references to trading volume in OCC's late exercise rule. The proposed rule change also adds a provision to OCC's exercise rule to provide expressly for the submission of exercise instructions through electronic means. (Rel. 34-36818)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-95-12) filed by The Options Clearing Corporation under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act. The proposed rule change amends the agreements governing non-proprietary cross-margining accounts of market professionals in the cross-margining program among OCC, the Intermarket Clearing Corporation (ICC), and the Chicago Mercantile Exchange, in the cross-margining program between OCC and ICC, and in the cross-margining program between OCC and the Kansas City Board of Trade Clearing Corporation.
