#### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### ALEXANDER HAMILTON LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Alexander Hamilton Life Insurance Company of America, Alexander Hamilton Variable Annuity Separate Account, Jefferson Pilot Financial Insurance Company, JPF Separate Account A, JPF Separate Account C, Jefferson Pilot LifeAmerica Insurance Company, JPF Separate Account B, Jefferson-Pilot Life Insurance Company, Jefferson-Pilot Separate Account A and Jefferson Pilot Investment Advisory Corporation (collectively, Applicants) The Applicants seek an order pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act approving the substitution of shares of the S&P 500 Index Portfolio of the Jefferson Pilot Variable Fund, Inc. (JPVF 500 Portfolio) for shares of the Fidelity Index 500 Portfolio of the Fidelity Variable Insurance Products Fund II (Fidelity 500 Portfolio). In addition, the Applicants request an order pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Act exempting them from Section 17(a) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the Applicants to carry out the substitution by means of in-kind redemption and purchase transactions. ## CALAMOS ADVISORS TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Calamos Advisors Trust (Fund) and Calamos Asset Management, Inc.
