NORAN CAMP, LEGAL COUNSEL TO CHAIRMAN LEVITT, TO LEAVE COMMISSION AFTER TEN YEARS OF SERVICE; DOUGLAS DAVISON NAMED AS SUCCESSOR

Noran J. Camp, Legal Counsel to Securities and Exchange Commission Chairman Arthur Levitt, today announced that he is leaving the Commission to join the San Francisco law office of Gibson, Dunn & Crutcher as Of Counsel. Also, Chairman Levitt today named Douglas J. Davison to succeed Mr. Camp.

Chairman Levitt said, "Noran has served the Commission and investors with distinction and commitment for a decade. I have benefited greatly from his wise counsel and warm friendship and will miss him much. Noran is admired by all for his genuineness, effectiveness, and thorough command of the securities laws. I wish him continued success and much happiness." Chairman Levitt added, "I am pleased to welcome Doug and look forward to working with him in his new position."

Mr. Camp said, "I have been honored to work at the Commission for the past ten years. While serving in the Office of the General Counsel, the Division of Enforcement, and the Chairman's Office, I have been privileged to work with the dedicated corps of professionals and support staff who make this agency great. It has been especially exciting to serve in the Chairman's Office during the past two and one-half years, a time of such dramatic changes in the securities markets. I particularly thank the Chairman for giving me the tremendous opportunity to serve the Commission and investors as his Legal Counsel. I will greatly miss working here, but look forward to new challenges in the private sector."

As Legal Counsel since April 1998, Mr. Camp has advised Chairman Levitt on all aspects of the Commission's enforcement program. Prior to this position he was Senior Special Trial Counsel in the Office of the General Counsel and then served as Assistant Chief Litigation Counsel in the Trial Unit of the Division of Enforcement. Mr. Camp successfully argued the case of *SEC v. Colello* to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. That case set important precedent in the law governing "relief defendants." Mr. Camp

also served as lead counsel or co-counsel on several complex securities enforcement actions.

Mr. Camp joined the Commission in 1990 after serving as an Associate at Willkie Farr & Gallagher in New York. From 1983 to 1985 he was a law clerk for U.S. Chief Judge Lawrence K. Karlton, of the Eastern District of California, at Sacramento. Mr. Camp, 43, graduated with a B.S. from Columbia University and earned his J.D. from the Yale Law School.

Chairman Levitt today named Douglas J. Davison to succeed Mr. Camp as Legal Counsel to the Chairman. As Legal Counsel, Mr. Davison will advise the Chairman primarily on enforcement matters.

Mr. Davison comes to this position from the Commission's Division of Enforcement where, as a Branch Chief since May 1999, he conducted and supervised a broad range of enforcement activities. He began his tenure at the Commission in 1997, serving first as a Staff Attorney and later as a Senior Counsel in the Division.

Prior to joining the Commission, Mr. Davison was an Associate at the law firm of Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott.

Mr. Davison, 31, earned his B.S. from the Pennsylvania State University and his J.D., *cum laude*, from the Dickinson School of Law of the Pennsylvania State University. (Press Rel. 2000-107)

PRIVACY ACT SYSTEM OF RECORDS

The SEC is proposing to delete "Personnel Management Security Files (SEC-41)," reserve the system number "SEC-41," and establish "Child Care Subsidy Program (SEC-41)," a new Privacy Act system of records. New SEC-41 will contain, among other things, financial and other personal information submitted by lower income Commission employees who apply for child care tuition subsidy.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

DAWSON-SAMBERG CAPITAL MANAGEMENT, INC., now known as DAWSON-GIAMMALVA CAPITAL MANAGEMENT, INC. FINED \$100,000 AND FIRM'S TREASURER FINED \$20,000 IN CONNECTION WITH SOFT DOLLAR VIOLATIONS, FAILURE TO SUPERVISE

On August 3, the Commission issued an Order against Dawson-Samberg Capital Management, Inc., now known as Dawson-Giammalva Capital Management, Inc., of Southport, Connecticut, a registered investment adviser, and Judith A. Mack, the firm's Treasurer. The Order requires Dawson-Giammalva to pay a \$100,000 penalty, representing a \$50,000 penalty for violations of the Advisers Act and \$50,000 for failure to supervise, requires Mack to pay a \$20,000 penalty, and imposes other relief. The sanctions are based on findings that: (i) between 1990 and 1996, Dawson-Samberg's disclosure of its soft dollar practices was inadequate because personal and non-research-related business travel, referral fees, other administrative expenses, such as training, subscriptions, replacement parts and software, and certain undocumented expenses, were paid using soft dollars but were not disclosed to clients; (ii) Mack, the corporate officer with day-to-day responsibility for administering Dawson-Samberg's soft dollar program, submitted invoices for payment using soft dollar credits without obtaining information necessary to ensure that Dawson-Samberg's soft dollar payments complied with its disclosure; (iii) at relevant times, Mack signed Dawson-Samberg's Forms ADV amendments which omitted to disclose certain of the firm's soft dollar practices; and (iv) Dawson-Samberg failed to supervise Mack by failing to establish adequate procedures for review of travel expenses and failing to conduct a periodic review of soft dollar vendors and the nature of services they provided in order to ensure that Dawson-Samberg's soft dollar relationships were adequately documented and disclosed. The Commission accepted Dawson-Giammalva's and Mack's offers of settlement, in which they agreed, without admitting or denying the findings, to the Order: (i) requiring Dawson-Giammalva, Dawson-Samberg's successor, to pay a fine of \$100,000; (ii) requiring Mack to pay a fine of \$20,000; (iii) censuring Dawson-Samberg, now known as Dawson-Giammalva and Mack; (iv) directing Dawson-Samberg, now known as Dawson-Giammalva and Mack to cease and desist from committing or causing violations of Sections 206(2) and 207 of the Advisers Act; and (v) requiring Dawson-Giammalva to perform various undertakings. DEADLINE FOR FILING PROOF OF CLAIM FORM BY CERTAIN PERSONS AND ENTITIES WHO SOLD SECURITIES OF VIVRA, INC. IS EXTENDED TO SEPTEMBER 15, 2000

In 1998, the Commission filed a civil action in United States District Court for the Southern District of New York alleging that the defendants engaged in illegal insider trading in securities of Vivra, Inc. Defendants disgorged profits of approximately \$370,000 which are now in a Fund under the control of a Court-appointed Receiver who

is responsible for distributing the fund on a pro rata basis to qualified claimants. (See Litigation Release No. 15840, August 11, 1998).

You may be eligible to receive a pro rata distribution from the Fund if you **sold** Vivra common stock on April 30, 1997, May 1, or May 2, 1997 and you timely file a Proof of Claim form and include all required information and documentation. Proof of Claim forms have been forwarded to potential claimants at their last known addresses. If you are a potential claimant and have not filed a claim or have not received a claim form, please note that the deadline for filing a Proof of Claim form has been extended to September 15, 2000. You may obtain a Proof of Claim form by contacting the Receiver or his agent at the address shown below.

HILLVIEW INVESTMENT TRUST II, ET AL.
