COMMISSION MEETINGS

OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 2000 - 10:00 A.M.

The subject matter of the open meeting will be:

The Commission will hear oral argument on an appeal by Seaboard Investment Advisers, Inc. and Eugene W. Hansen (together, Respondents) as well as the Division of Enforcement from an administrative law judge's initial decision.

The law judge found that the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia had issued an order, with Respondents' consent without admitting or denying liability, permanently enjoining the Respondents from violating Sections 206(1), 206(2), and 206(4) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and Advisers Act Rule 206(4)-1(a)(5) and from violating an earlier Commission Order Making Findings and Imposing

Remedial Sanctions and Cease and Desist Order. On the basis of the injunction, the law judge revoked the registration of Seaboard and suspended Hansen from being associated with an investment adviser for a period of twelve months.

Among the issues likely to be argued are the following:

- (1) whether the record establishes that the Respondents were permanently enjoined from violating antifraud provisions of the securities laws and from violating an earlier Commission cease-and-desist order; and
- (2) if so, what sanction, if any, is appropriate in the public interest.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF RALPH LEBLANC

On November 21, an administrative law judge issued an initial decision In the Matter of Ralph W. LeBlanc. The Division of Enforcement (Division) alleged that from 1992 through February 1996, Respondent LeBlanc participated in the offer and sale of Alpha

Diversified Industries, Inc. (Alpha) common stock, which was a "penny stock" as defined by the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules thereunder, and that through that period Respondent LeBlanc was president and chairman of the board of directors of Alpha. The Division further alleged that on September 10, 1997, the Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) commenced an action, <u>SEC v. Alpha Diversified Industries, Inc., et al.</u>, Civil Action No. 97-2814 "B" (E.D. La.), in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana, and on March 26, 1999, the Court entered a judgment enjoining Respondent LeBlanc from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The administrative law judge found that Respondent LeBlanc had been so enjoined and that it was in the public interest that he be barred from participating in an offering of penny stock.

Consequently, in the initial decision, pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Exchange Act, Respondent Ralph W. LeBlanc was barred from participating in an offering of penny stock. (Initial Decision No. 174; File No. 3-10065)

NASD CENSURE AND FINE OF KEITH PERKINS SUSTAINED

The Commission sustained the disciplinary action the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) imposed on Keith S. Perkins, a general securities representative.

The NASD had found that Perkins violated Conduct Rule 2110 by creating and submitting false expense receipts for reimbursement of costs he did not incur. The NASD had censured Perkins and imposed a \$7,500 fine. (Rel. 34-43599; File No. 3-10109)

SEC SUES JEFFREY LEACH, HUBERT LEACH AND LMC ASSETS CORP. FOR FRAUDULENT MINI TENDER OFFERS

The Commission today announced the filing of a lawsuit against Jeffrey L. Leach, his brother Hubert A. Leach, both of whom are residents of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and LMC Assets Corp., for fraud in connection with three mini tender offers. The complaint alleges that Jeffrey and Hubert Leach, president and former vice-president of LMC Assets, made millions of dollars in unlawful profits, and caused investors to suffer millions of dollars in losses, by making fraudulent mini tender offers for shares of Fleming Companies, Inc., Fruit of the Loom, Ltd., and Mattel, Inc. Mini tender offers are offers for less than five percent of a class of securities registered with the Commission. The fraudulent offers were made through two shell corporations that Jeffrey Leach created and controlled – defendant LMC Assets and Carnegie Investment Management, Ltd., a Cayman Islands company that recently filed a petition for bankruptcy.

The complaint alleges that all three tender offers were fraudulent for several reasons, including:

- The offering documents contained material omissions and false statements about the offeror's intent in making the offer, its ability to pay for the tendered shares, and other material matters.
- The defendants made numerous false and misleading statements outside of the offering documents; in particular, they made many false promises to tendering shareholders that they would be paid for their shares, typically by a date certain, and simply never paid for many shares tendered.
- The defendants structured the offers without the use of any escrow account or independent receiving agent, and failed to disclose that they could not pay for the shares; thus, they gained control of the shares before payment and obtained the equivalent of an unsecured loan and a free call option on the tendered shares. The defendants then used the unpaid-for shares as collateral to receive millions of dollars in cash from margin loans and to engage in extremely risky margin trading schemes.
- The defendants engaged in other practices that are specifically unlawful in connection with tender offers. For example, the defendants unlawfully amended the Mattel offer by changing the offering price but failing to give shareholders sufficient time to consider the amended offer. The defendants also unilaterally and illegally amended the Fruit of the Loom offer five weeks after its purported closing, and coerced shareholders into accepting a significantly lower price or the return of their shares. And, in connection with all three offers, the defendants failed to pay for or return the shares promptly after the close of each offer.

The Commission's complaint seeks to permanently enjoin Jeffrey Leach, Hubert Leach and LMC Assets from violating Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-1 thereunder. The complaint also seeks disgorgement of all ill-gotten gains and losses avoided, prejudgment interest, and civil monetary penalties against the defendants. [SEC v. Jeffrey L. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PMC CAPITAL, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by PMC Capital, Inc., et al. under the Investment Company Act. The order permits (1) a business development company (BDC) to engage in a loan origination agreement with an affiliated real estate investment trust (REIT), (2) investment management agreements between the REIT and subsidiaries of the BDC, and (3) the establishment of special purpose entities owned by the BDC and the REIT to engage in joint loan securitizations. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE OPTIONS INTERMARKET LINKAGE PLAN

The Commission approved an amendment to the Options Intermarket Linkage Plan (Linkage Plan) submitted pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> to add the Phlx as a participant to the Linkage Plan. (Rel. 34-43573)

The Commission approved an amendment to the Options Intermarket Linkage Plan (Linkage Plan) submitted pursuant to Rule 11Aa3-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by the <u>Pacific Exchange</u> to add the PCX as a participant to the Linkage Plan. (Rel. 34-43574)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>National Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-00-11) under Section 19(b)(1) of the Exchange Act. The Commission approved on an accelerated basis the proposed rule change which modifies NSCC's rules and procedures pertaining to account transfers in its Automated Customer Account Transfer Service. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 27. (Rel. 34-43597)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u>, through its wholly owned subsidiary NASD Regulation, Inc. (SR-NASD-00-58), under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 relating to member firm transactions with association employees. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 20. (Rel. 34-43580)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-00-15) filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers that amends NASD Rule 2520, "Margin Requirements," to revise the margin requirements for certain options and warrants. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 20. (Rel. 34-43581)
