RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENTS CONCERNING THE EXEMPTION FOR THE ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES DURING THE EXISTENCE OF AN UNDERWRITING OR SELLING SYNDICATE

The Commission issued a release proposing amendments to Rule 10f-3 under the Investment Company Act. The proposed amendments would expand the exemption provided by the rule to permit a fund to purchase government securities in a syndicated offering. The proposed amendments also would modify the rule's quantitative limit on purchases to improve the effectiveness of that limit.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF PIPER CAPITAL MANAGEMENT, INC., ET AL.

Administrative Law Judge H. Peter Young issued an initial decision today in the abovereferenced matter. The Commission's Order Instituting Public Proceedings (OIP) alleged numerous securities laws violations against Piper Capital Management, Inc. (PCM) and various PCM employees in connection with the 1994 collapse of the Piper Jaffray Institutional Government Income Portfolio, a diversified mutual fund. The administrative proceedings were instituted in order to determine whether the allegations in the OIP were true and, if so, whether the imposition of sanctions was in the public interest.

Judge Young determined that the conduct attributable to PCM- particularly through the fund's primary portfolio manager- recklessly violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Section 13(a)(3) of the Investment Company Act by materially deviating from the "consistent with preservation of capital" component of the fund's stated investment objective and failing either to disclose the deviation or to obtain shareholder authorization for it. In addition, Judge Young determined that the fund misrepresented or failed to disclose numerous material facts concerning fund composition, duration, performance, weighted average life, diversification and leverage in fund prospectuses and marketing materials, finding that the fund's co-manager negligently violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 as a consequence. Judge Young also determined that the fund co-manager and various other PCM employees recklessly violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5, Rule 22c-1 promulgated pursuant to Section 22(c) of the Investment Company

Act, Section 31(a) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 31a-1 thereunder, and Section 34(b) of the Investment Company Act by participating in an effort to incorporate fund losses into the net asset value (NAV) over a period of days and reporting inaccurate NAVs for the fund in the interim. Judge Young determined that numerous misrepresentations concerning the primary portfolio manager's educational background constituted intentional violations of Section 207 of the Investment Advisers Act as well.

Judge Young ordered PCM to cease and desist from violating, or causing violations of, the federal securities laws, censured PCM for the violations attributed to it in the initial decision, revoked PCM's registration to operate as an investment advisor, and imposed monetary penalties on PCM totaling Two Million Five Thousand Dollars (U.S. \$2,005,000.00). Although the judge determined that the conduct attributable to the fund co-manager and other PCM employees was inappropriate and reckless in significant degree, he determined it was not egregious in light of the extraordinary circumstances which confronted them. Judge Young therefore ordered each of them to cease and desist from violating, or causing violations of, the federal securities laws and censured them for their violations. He expressly determined it was not in the public interest to bar any of them from investment advisor or investment company association or to impose monetary sanctions on them. (Initial Decision No. 175; File No. 3-9657)

EAJA AWARD – RICHARD ADAMS

Richard J. Adams was awarded fees and expenses incurred in defending against charges brought against him in an administrative proceeding. The award was made pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), which allows individuals to recover expenses of defending against charges brought by the U.S. Government that are not substantially justified. An EAJA applicant must prevail in the Government's proceeding against him and must also show that the Government's position was not reasonable in law or fact and thus was not substantially justified. The purpose of the EAJA is to eliminate for the average person the financial disincentive to challenge unreasonable government action.

Adams, formerly of Graystone Nash, Incorporated, had been charged with willfully violating Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 15(c) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 10b-6, and 15c1-2, thereunder, in connection with certain of Graystone Nash's sales of common stock. All allegations against him were dismissed after a hearing by an administrative law judge.

In ruling on Adams's EAJA claim, the law judge concluded that Adams is an eligible prevailing applicant, pursuant to the EAJA, that the proceeding against him was not substantially justified and that he incurred the expenses he claimed for his defense. The amount awarded was \$53,646.03. (Initial Decision No. 176; File No. 3-8327-EAJA)

JOSEPH MONACO BARRED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER OR DEALER AND FROM PARTICIPATION IN ANY OFFERING OF A PENNY STOCK

On November 30, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions Pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Order) against Joseph Monaco (Monaco). The Order bars Monaco from association with any broker or dealer and from participation in any offering of a penny stock.

The Order states the Commission filed a complaint against Monaco charging that he participated in a Ponzi scheme operated by Legend Sports from 1994 to 1996. The complaint alleged Monaco oversaw a sales force that raised \$18 million from the sale of Legend Sports securities and that he failed to disclose, among other things, the substantial commissions he and his salesmen received for selling the securities. On October 21, 1999, the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida issued an order enjoining Monaco from violating the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws (SEC v. James T. Staples, et al., Civil Action No. 98-1061-CIV-22C, M.D. Fla.).

In addition to the sanctions imposed by the Order, the district court ordered Monaco to disgorge \$6 million of Legend Sport's fraudulently obtained profits and to pay a \$100,000 penalty. Monaco is serving three years in a Florida prison for his participation in the Legend Sports scheme. (Rel. 34-43644; File No. 3-10213)

COURT ORDERS PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AGAINST CHARLES EDWARDS AND ETS PAYPHONES, INC. AND IMPOSES A FREEZE ON ASSETS OF EDWARDS

The Commission announced that on November 20, 2000, Judge Jack T. Camp of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia entered a preliminary injunction against Charles E. Edwards (Edwards) to prevent further violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The court also imposed a freeze on Edwards' assets as a result of his conduct in the ETS securities offering. A preliminary injunction hearing was held in this matter on October 12, 2000, which Edwards contested. By a separate order of October 25, 2000, ETS Payphones, Inc. (ETS) was preliminarily enjoined from violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The commission did not seek a freeze of ETS's assets, because the company had previously filed for reorganization in the bankruptcy court.

In its ruling of November 20, 2000, the Court found that Edwards and ETS fraudulently sold unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts in the form of coinoperated telephones in units including a telephone, site lease, lease/back agreement and buy/back agreement. The Court found that ETS falsely advertised in sales brochures the "profitability" of payphones and encouraged investors to "watch the profits add up," while in reality ETS always lost money on its payphone operations. The Court concluded that because revenue from payphone operations never covered operating expenses, ETS had to attract an ever expanding number of investors to meet its obligations to the existing investors and that none of this information was disclosed to investors. The Court found that Edwards as founder of ETS personally profited from the operation receiving substantial compensation. The Court noted that Edwards owned real estate valued in excess of \$7 million, and that ETS transferred more than \$11.6 million in interest free loans to companies controlled by Edwards.

The complaint, filed on September 30, 2000, seeks permanent injunctions against ETS and Edwards to prevent future violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint also seeks an accounting, disgorgement and prejudgment interest as well as civil penalties from the defendants. The complaint alleges that the two parties engaged in fraud in the offer and sale of unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts, and alleges that the defendants promoted a massive fraudulent scheme through the use of insurance agents and over the Internet, in which ETS raised more than \$300 million from more than 10,000 mostly elderly investors. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NORTHEAST UTILITIES, ET AL.

An amended notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 26, 2000, to request a hearing on a proposal by Northeast Utilities (NU), a registered holding company, its service company subsidiary, Northeast Service Company (Service), and its public utility subsidiaries, Western Massachusetts Electric Company, Connecticut Light and Power Company, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company, Yankee Energy System, Inc., Yankee Gas Services Company, Holyoke Water Power Company, Public Service Company of New Hampshire and North Atlantic Energy Corporation and NU's nonutility subsidiaries. Under the proposal, NU, its public utility subsidiaries and its nonutility subsidiaries will extend their short-term debt program, including the issuance and sale of notes and commercial paper and system money pool borrowings, at existing levels and under the same terms and conditions as are authorized currently, through June 30, 2003. The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed Amendment No. 2 to a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-99-60) relating to purchase and sale of initial equity public offerings. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43627)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The <u>Emerging Markets Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-EMCC-00-06), which became effective upon filing, to modify EMCC's procedures regarding issuing reports concerning warrants with a money distribution. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43629)

<u>The Options Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-00-08), which became effective upon filing, to allow OCC to give effect on an intra-day basis to instructions to pledge long options positions and instructions to release pledges. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 4.

<u>The Depository Trust Company</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-00-15), which became effective upon filing, to allow DTC to modify its current fees for DTAX in connection with providing Internet access to the DTAX information database. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43634)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-00-68), which became effective upon filing, to amend Rule 11870(e) of the Uniform Practice Code to require that following the validation of a transfer instruction, the carrying member must complete the transfer of customer account(s) to the receiving member within three business days instead of four business days. Publication of the proposal is expected in Federal Register during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43635)

<u>The Depository Trust Company</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-00-14), which became effective upon filing, to allow DTC to institute a U.S. withholding tax service for foreign participants beginning January 1, 2001, in which DTC will act as withholding agent to deduct and withhold U.S. tax on U.S.-source income paid to foreign participants. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43631)

The <u>Options Clearing Corporation</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-00-05), which took effect upon filing, to allow OCC to amend its By-Laws to explicitly state a long standing policy with respect to stockholder approval of certain amendments to the By-Laws. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 4. (Rel. 34-43630)
