

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC, CANADIAN PROVINCES TO SIGN HISTORIC AGREEMENT ON SECURITIES LAW ENFORCEMENT

The Commission will sign an agreement with far-reaching implications for international enforcement of the securities laws with Canadian securities regulators. The agreement is more comprehensive than any similar one signed to date. Signing will be on Thursday, January 7th at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission's Meeting Room, Room 1C30, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC. (Press Release 88-1)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST MUSIKAHN CORPORATION, OTHERS

The New York Regional Office filed a civil injunctive action on January 4 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York against Musikahn Corporation, Citiwide Securities Corp., Gerard F. Binder, Ernest G. Barbella, Calvin Kohler, Arthur G. Wachs, Nabil Elkadi, Herbert S. Cannon, and Alan Deitch.

The Complaint alleges that Musikahn and certain of the other defendants engaged in fraudulent conduct in connection with a public offering of Musikahn securities which occurred in July 1984 through March 1985, in violation of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and applicable Commission rules. Among other things, the Complaint alleges that Musikahn was able to close the offering, which required that a minimum of 2,500,000 units be sold, only by resort to <u>non bona fide</u> nominee transactions which certain of the defendants arranged. The Complaint further alleges that subsequently Musikahn failed to file with the Commission certain periodic and other reports required by applicable laws and regulations, including annual and quarterly reports, reports of its use of the offering proceeds and reports of certain corporate events of Form 8-K.

Simultaneously, Musikahn, Binder, Barbella, and Wachs consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against them in settlement of the Commission's charges. (SEC v. Musikahn Corporation, et al., 88 Civ. 0002, JES, USDC SDNY). (LR-11635)

COMPLAINT NAMES WILLIAM RAY WHITE

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices filed a civil complaint on December 14, 1987 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against William Ray White. The Complaint seeks preliminary and permanent injunctions enjoining White from further violations of the antifraud provisions.

The Complaint alleges that White, representing himself to be a representative of a broker-dealer, induced a financial institution to invest approximately \$700,000 for the purchase of United States zero coupon treasury notes, and misappropriated the investor's funds. The Complaint further alleges that White provided the investor with confirmations which falsely indicated that treasury notes, with a face value of \$7 million, had been purchased on margin. In addition, the Complaint alleges that White obtained and misappropriated an additional \$238,000 from the financial institution by falsely representing that funds were needed to meet "margin calls" related to the purported investment. (SEC v. William Ray White, Civil Action No. 87-6971-CIV-ZLOCH). (LR-11636)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CASH RESERVE MANAGEMENT, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Cash Reserve Management, Inc., and certain other registered investment companies for which E.F. Hutton & Company Inc. (Hutton) serves as investment adviser, Hutton, and SLBP Acquisition Corp. (SLBP), subsidiary of Shearson Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc., conditionally exempting the investment companies, Hutton, and SLBP from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act to the extent necessary to permit Hutton to continue serving as an investment adviser to the investment companies under interim advisory contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, a registered holding company, to finance pollution control facilities in an amount up to \$50 million by issuing a note and its collateral first mortgage bonds in the same principal amount. (Rel. 35-24545 - Dec. 28, 1987)

MSU SYSTEM SERVICES, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing MSU System Services, Inc. (Services), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc. (MSU), to borrow and reborrow through December 31, 1989 up to an aggregate principal amount of \$30 million at any one time outstanding, pursuant to a new loan agreement with MSU and/or under a bank line(s) of credit to be negotiated. MSU is authorized to guarantee Services' obligations to any such bank(s). Jurisdiction is reserved over the terms and conditions of such bank borrowing arrangements. (Rel. 35-24546 - Dec. 28, 1987)

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to sell to Riegel Products Corporation, for \$4,050,000, certain property consisting of a turbine, an electric generator, a computer, an electric substation and auxiliary equipment, all located at Riegel's electric generating facility in Milford, New Jersey. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
