## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

---

### CHAIRMAN SPEAKS ON "SEC RESPONSES TO THE OCTOBER MARKET BREAK"

Chairman Ruder today reiterated the Commission's call for the stock exchanges, futures exchanges, and market regulators to take steps swiftly to enhance capacity and contain volatility in the securities markets, and called for increased efforts toward global regulatory cooperation.

"Our current market for securities is a linked market formed by stock index futures, stock index options, and stocks ... under current conditions, new institutional trading mechanisms and strategies in this linked market can cause extraordinary peak volume and volatility," said Chairman Ruder in addressing the 23rd Annual Outlook Conference of the Conference Board in New York City. "The Commission has recommended three broad approaches for reform of the market: (1) expanding capacities of the markets, (2) increasing coordination among markets, and (3) retarding volatility and volume of trading during crisis periods." ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST GILBERT C. SCHULMAN

The New York Regional Office announced that on January 28 U.S. District Court Judge Dickinson R. Debevoise, District of New Jersey, entered a Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Gilbert C. Schulman, a New Jersey resident and former principal of Bevill, Bresler & Schulman, Inc. (BBS) and its affiliates. Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, Schulman consented to the Final Judgment which permanently enjoins him from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. John Rooney, Robert Bevill, Robert Levine, co-principals, and William Langheld and Stuart Gottlieb, former BBS employees, all co-defendants, had previously been similarly enjoined.

The Complaint alleges, among other things, that Schulman, along with other defendants, caused BBS and its affiliates to enter into repurchase agreements in government securities using securities which were already pledged in other repurchase agreements. Certain corporate defendants were also charged with violating recordkeeping and net capital provisions. (SEC v. Bevill, Bresler & Schulman Asset Management Corp., et al., Civil Action No. 85-1715, DRD, DNJ). (LR-11670)

### COLONIAL VALUE INVESTING PORTFOLIOS-INCOME PORTFOLIO
