The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-88-1) to amend Schedule D of its By-Laws and its rules governing its Small Order Execution System (SOES). Among other things, the proposed rule change would (1) make SOES participation mandatory for all market makers in NASDAQ/NMS securities; (2) raise the penalty for market makers who withdraw from NASDAQ on an unexcused basis; (3) limit the acceptable reasons for excused withdrawal from NASDAQ; (4) enable the NASD to establish different maximum order size limits for SOES orders; (5) provide that SOES executions will continue in NASDAQ/NMS securities when quotes are locked or crossed; and (6) eliminate preferencing of market makers when the mrket for a NMS security is locked or crossed.
