ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

APPEAL OF FIRST FLORIDA SECURITIES GROUP, INC. AND HENRY H. WINKLER, JR. DISMISSED AS MOOT

> The Commission dismissed as moot an appeal from NASD action by First Florida Securities Group, Inc., of Pompano Beach, Florida, and Henry H. Winkler, Jr., of Lakeland, Florida. The NASD had denied First Florida's application to remain an NASD member with Winkler as an associated person, an application that was necessary because Winkler is subject to a statutory disqualification, a 1972 Commission bar order. In dismissing the appeal as moot, the Commission noted that First Florida has ceased operations and is in the process of withdrawing its broker-dealer and NASD registration. (Rel. 34-25494)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SUN LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF CANADA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada (U.S.); Money Market Variable Account; High Yield Variable Capital; Capital Appreciation Variable Account; Government Guaranteed Variable Account; Government Markets Variable Account; Total Return Variable Account; Managed Sectors Variable Account (collectively, Variable Accounts); and Clarendon Insurance Agency, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 12(b), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 12b-1. The order would permit the deduction of mortality, expense, and distribution risk charges assessed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the Variable Accounts. (Rel. Another notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Sun Life, Government Markets, Total Return, Managed Sectors (collectively, Variable Accounts), and Clarendon Insurance for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 12(b) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 12b-1. The order would permit the deduction of the mortality and expense risk charges assessed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the Variable Accounts. (Rel. IC-16337 - March 23)

SUN LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITY COMPANY OF NEW YORK

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Sun Life Insurance and Annuity Company of New York, Sun Life (N.Y.) Variable Account B (the Variable Account), and Clarendon Insurance Agency, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act. The order would permit the deduction of the mortality and expense risk charges and the distribution expense risk charge assessed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the Variable Accounts. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-88-2) to extend the portfolio execution pilot program. (Rel. 34-25493)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: <u>The Philadelphia Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> (SR-Phlx-88-7) to establish Cash Index Participation (CIP) trading rules and to list for trading CIPs based on two broad-based stock indices developed by Phlx. (Rel. 34-25495); and <u>The Midwest Clearing Corporation</u> (SR-MCC-87-5) to establish a service and related procedures to process mutual fund transactions, Fund-Serv. It also would create a new category of membership, Fund-Serv-only participants, and set standards for admitting Fund-Serv-only participants. (Rel. 34-25497)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 21.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>The American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Amex-88-5) to amend its policy to allow the inclusion of stocks traded over-thecounter as components of stock index industry groups. (Rel. 34-25499)

APPROVAL OF SIPC'S SERIES 500 RULES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Securities Investor Protection Corporation (SIPC Series 500 Rules) that provides a uniform procedure for the satisfaction of claims for cash and claims for securities in a liquidation proceeding under the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970.
