U.S. SEGURITILS AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

AMENDMENT TO RULE 174 AND TECHNICAL AMENDMENT TO RULE 15c2-8 ADOPTED

> The Commission published a release adopting: (1) an amendment to Rule 174 under the Securities Act of 1933 to reduce the aftermarket prospectus delivery period following registered offerings by non-reporting companies to 25 calendar days for securities listed on an exchange or authorized for inclusion in an electronic inter-dealer quotation system of a registered securities association; and (2) a technical amendment to Rule 15c2-8 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. These amendments are effective for public offerings beginning after publication date in the Federal Register. (Rel. 33-6763)

TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN THE SECURITIES OF 46 ISSUERS

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of 46 issuers for the period beginning at 9:30 a.m. (BDT) on April 5 and terminating at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on April 14. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of the 46 companies in view of information that gives it reason to believe that false statements have been made concerning, among other things, claims for exemption from the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 made by these companies and pursuant to which their securities are trading, and the corporate history, stock ownership and financial condition of these companies. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GS MORTGAGE SECURITIES CORP.

An order has been issued on an application filed by GS Mortgage Securities Corp. amending a prior order [Rel. IC-15670, April 8, 1987] exempting it and certain trusts from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and beneficial interests in such trusts. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed Amendment No. 4 to a proposed rule change (SR-Amex-83-27) that would expand and clarify the contents of its specialist unit evaluation questionnaire. (Rel. 34-25542)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-5) to raise the limit on the size of claims eligible for simplified arbitration procedures from \$5,000 to \$10,000, to establish a filing fee of \$200 where the case and controversy is between \$5,000 and \$10,000, to eliminate the requirement for five member panels in claims exceeding \$500,000, and to increase administrative fees retained for cases withdrawn or settled prior to their first hearing session. PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-88-5) to modify the opening rotation process for S & P 100 Index Options (OEX) so as to provide for a more rapid opening for the OEX, especially during extreme market conditions. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
