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## **COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS**

U.S. SECURITIES AND

RECOMMENDATIONS ON ACCOUNTING AND AUDITING ADDED TO COMMISSION CALENDAR

> The Commission will consider an additional item at the previously announced open meeting on Wednesday, April 27 at 10:30 a.m. (a change from 10:00 a.m.).

> That item, to be discussed first, will be recommendations of the National Commission on Fraudulent Financial Reporting. The National Commission, a private-sector initiative headed by former SEC Commissioner James C. Treadway, was a blue-ribbon panel formed to consider means of improving the quality of financial reporting by publiclytraded companies. The National Commission published a number of recommendations for change in its final report of October 1987. (Press Release 88-36)

ANITA M. NAGLER NAMED ASSOCIATE REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR (ENFORCEMENT)

Chicago Regional Office (CRO) Administrator William D. Goldsberry announced the appointment of Anita M. Nagler as Associate Regional Administrator (Enforcement) with responsibility for the Enforcement program of the CRO. In her new position, Ms. Nagler becomes a member of the Senior Executive Service.

Ms. Nagler graduated from the University of Illinois in 1977 and from Chicago-Kent College of Law with highest honors in 1980. She joined the Commission in 1980 immediately after graduation, and has served as an enforcement staff attorney in the Chicago and Los Angeles offices, as a Special Counsel - Enforcement in the CRO, as an Enforcement Branch Chief in the Chicago and Los Angeles offices, and as Assistant Regional Administrator - Enforcement in the CRO since August 1985.

## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PETROFAB INTERNATIONAL STOP ORDER ISSUED

The Commission issued a Stop Order suspending the effectiveness of a registration statement filed under the Securities Act of 1933 by Petrofab International, Inc. of Seattle. The statement covered a proposed public offering of 30 million shares of the company's stock at 10¢ per share. Petrofab was organized in 1980 to design and manufacture oilfield exploration and drilling equipment.

In determining to issue a Stop Order, the Commission found that Petrofab's financial statements substantially overstated the company's revenues and income due to improper accounting treatment of a research and development contract. Under that contract, a Petrofab subsidiary agreed to undertake research and development with respect to a personnel transfer and evacuation system for offshore drilling platforms. The Commission concluded that the contract was in fact a financing arrangement and, therefore, that Petrofab's recognition of revenue thereunder was improper.

The Commission also found the registration statement materially misleading because it contained the auditors' unqualified consent to the use of their audit report on the financial statements. In fact, in an undisclosed agreement with Petrofab, the auditors withdrew or at least materially modified their consent to make it conditional. (Rel. 33-6769)

## **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

ACTION FILED AGAINST MARTIN M. ROTHSCHILD FOR FAILURE TO FILE TIMELY FORMS 4

The Commission today filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking a Final Order against Martin M. Rothschild of East Amherst, New York, requiring him in the future to file timely Form 4 Statements of Changes in Beneficial Ownership of Securities, as required by Section 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Rule 16a-1, and Form 4. Simultaneously, Rothschild, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, consented to a Final Order. (SEC v. Martin M. Rothschild, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 88-1141). (LR-11714)

## COMPLAINT NAMES OLIVIER MANAGEMENT CORPORATION

The Commission today filed an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Olivier Management Corporation of Miami, Florida. The Complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Olivier, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended March 31, 1987, its Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended September 30 and December 31, 1986, June 30, September 30 and December 31, 1987, eight Notifications of Late Filing on Form 12b-25, and Reports of Sales of Securities and Use of Proceeds Therefrom on Form SR. The Commission requests that the Court order Olivier to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. #### SUN LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF CANADA

An order has been issued on an application filed by Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada (U.S.), Money Market Variable Account, High Yield Variable Account, Capital Appreciation Variable Account, Government Guaranteed Variable Account, Government Markets Variable Account, Total Return Variable Account, Managed Sectors Variable Account (collectively, Variable Accounts), and Clarendon Insurance Agency, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 12(b), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 12b-1. The order permits the deduction of mortality, expense and distribution risk charges assessed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the Variable Accounts. (Rel. IC-16377 - April 25)

An order has also been issued on an application filed by Sun Life, Government Markets, Total Return, Managed Sectors, and Clarendon for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 12(b) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 12b-1. The order permits the deduction of the mortality and expense risk charges assessed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the variable accounts. (Rel. IC-16379 - April 25)

### SUN LIFE INSURANCE AND ANNUITY COMPANY OF NEW YORK

An order has been issued on an application filed by Sun Life Insurance and Annuity Company of New York, Sun Life (N.Y.) Variable Account B, and Clarendon Insurance Agency, Inc. granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35), 26(a)(2), and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits the deduction of mortality and expense risk charge and the distribution risk charge assessed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the Variable Account. (Rel. IC-16378 - April 25)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
