## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY FACILITY LOAN TRUST TWO

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An order has been issued on an application filed by The First National Bank of Boston, not in its individual capacity, but solely as Trustee, on behalf of the College and University Facility Loan Trust Two (Trust), in connection with the Federal government's loan asset sale program. The order conditionally exempts the Trust from the provisions of Sections 10(h), 14(a), 16(a), 17(a), 18(a), (c) and (i), and 32(a) of the Investment Company Act such that the Trust may issue bonds and senior and junior certificates of beneficial interests in the Trust, collateralized by certain loans originated by the U.S. Department of Education. ### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GULF POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Gulf Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell up to \$35 million principal amount of first mortgage bonds to an institutional investor at an interest rate of 9.20%. Jurisdiction has been reserved over all other proposed transactions pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-24632 - April 28)

#### EASTERN POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Eastern Power Company, subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, to extend the period from April 30 to May 31, 1988 during which Eastern Edison may issue and sell, in one or more series, from time to time, by competitive bidding not more than \$100 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds and collateral trust bonds. #### LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: <u>Cincinnati Stock</u> <u>Exchange</u> - 25 and 21 issues (two separate applications). (Rel. 34-25638; 34-25639); and the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> - six issues. (Rel. 34-25640)

### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-88-3) to amend the pricing procedure of odd-lot market and limit orders executed on the Exchange floor. (Rel. 34-25633); and The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-13) to add a provision to its Interpretation of the Board of Governors - Review of Corporate Financing, Article III, Section 1 of the Rules of Fair Practice to prohibit non-cash sales incentives in connection with distribution of public offerings. (Rel. 34-25636)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 2.

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-55) that will (1) establish a mandatory price and volume reporting system for over-the-cuonter securities that are not part of the NASDAQ System (pink sheet stocks); and (2) amend its Best Execution Interpretation (Article III, Section 1 of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice) relating to retail transactions in pink sheet stocks. ORDER EXTENDING APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE ON A TEMPORARY BASIS

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-87-12) that would establish, among other things, a new category of broker-dealer membership whose activities would be restricted exclusively to use of the Fund/SERV service. In January 1988, the Commission approved the proposed rule change on a temporary basis, through April 30, and requested NSCC to provide information concerning benefits accruing from lower fund contributions by this new category of membership. To enable Commission review of that information, the Commission is extending approval of the proposed rule change on a temporary basis through June 30. (Rel. 34-25641)

### TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

#### CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 26 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp, a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four Citicorp indentures and under a Pooling and Servicing Agreement of Citicorp Mortgage Securities, Inc., subsidiary of Citicorp, with respect to Citicorp's obligations as guarantor, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee under any of these indentures or the Agreement.
