CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ATKINSON BROTHERS SENTENCED

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Central District of California announced that on May 9 District Judge Ronald Lew sentenced attorney Edward J. Atkinson to five years in prison, five years probation, and 200 hours of community service. Atkinson was found guilty on March 28 by a jury of perjury in a Commission investigation and of conspiring to file and filing false financial reports with the Commission on behalf of the Video Station, Inc., a Los Angeles company which was a pioneer in the videocassette rental industry, and of which Atkinson was secretary-treasurer and a director.

On May 2, George W. Atkinson, who pleaded guilty before trial of filing false financial statements on behalf of the company with the Commission, was sentenced to three months in a community treatment center, five years of probation, and 2,000 hours of community service. JOHN P. ROBERTS SENTENCED

The U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia and the Atlanta Regional Office announced that on May 11 Chief Judge William C. O'Kelly sentenced John P. Roberts of Marietta, Georgia to ten years in prison, five years probation, and \$174,000 restitution, with probation contingent upon restitution. Roberts had previously, on April 4, pled guilty to one count of fraud under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and two counts of mail fraud.

On September 29, 1986, Roberts and American Monetary Corporation (AMC), formerly a registered investment adviser owned and controlled by Roberts, pursuant to their consent, were enjoined from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Investment Advisers Act in an action brought by the Commission [SEC v. American Monetary Corp. and John P. Roberts, USDC NDGA, Civil Action No. 86-2082A]. As a result of a related administrative proceeding, AMC's registration as an investment adviser was revoked, and Roberts was barred from associating with any investment adviser or broker-dealer. (U.S. v. John P. Roberts, USDC NDGA, Cr 87-300-A). (LR-11743)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EQUITABLE CAPITAL PARTNERS L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by Equitable Capital Partners, L.P., Equitable Capital Partners (Retirement Fund), L.P. (collectively, the Partnerships) and Equitable Capital Management Corporation (Adviser) for an order determining that (a) the Independent General Partners of the Partnerships are not "interested persons," within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, of the Partnerships or the Adviser, and (b) limited partners who own less than 5% equity interest in a Partnership will not be deemed "affiliated persons" (as defined by Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Act) of the Partnership or other partners solely by reason of being limited partners. VICTORIAN PUBLIC AUTHORITIES FINANCE AGENCY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by Victorian Public Authorities Finance Agency, a public authority of the State of Victoria, Australia, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the offer and sale of its debt securities in the United States. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of three issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-88-6) and granted accelerated approval to proposed rule changes filed by the CBOE and the American, New York, Pacific, and Philadelphia Stock Exchanges (SR-CBOE-88-8; SR-Amex-88-12; SR-NYSE-88-13; SR-PSE-88-4; SR-Phlx-88-19) to increase margin requirements for equity and index options. (Rel. 34-25701)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes filed by the following have become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934: The Midwest Clearing Corporation (SR-MCC-88-5) consisting of amendments to fees for its Bond Comparison System. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
