ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND Mail Commission

GEORGE S. GOLDNER SANCTIONED

The Commission issued Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions against George S. Goldner, a registered investment adviser, and thereby settled public administrative proceedings instituted against him on August 14, 1987. By its Order, the Commission prohibited Goldner from associating, in any capacity, with any investment adviser, investment company, broker, dealer, or municipal securities dealer for 45 days.

The Commission accepted Goldner's Offer of Settlement wherein he (1) admitted that he failed to provide advisory clients with Part II of his Form ADV or its equivalent, to amend his Form ADV to reflect his actual fee structure, and to maintain required books and records (violations of Section 204 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940); (2) consented, without admitting or denying the alleged violations, to Commission findings that he published, distributed, or circulated misleading advertisements (violations of Section 206(4) of the Advisers Act); and (3) consented to the Commission's Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions. SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST WESTMARK FINANCIAL SERVICES, CORP. AND NIDA RAE ELLIS

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Sections 203(e) and 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Westmark Financial Services, Corp., a New Mexico investment adviser, and its vice president, Nida Rae Ellis. The Commission simultaneously accepted Offers of Settlement submitted by Westmark and Ellis in which they consented, without admitting or denying findings of violations, to an Order Making Findings and Imposing Sanctions.

The Order makes findings that Westmark and Ellis violated the Advisers Act antifraud provisions by breaching their fiduciary duty to clients by: failing to state they would receive commissions for sale of certain securities they had recommended; failing to disclose clients could purchase securities from other than Westmark's affiliated broker-dealer; and recommending securities unsuitable for their clients. The Commission also found that respondents failed to distribute Part II of Form ADV or equivalent information to their clients in violation of the brochure rule.

The Order suspends Ellis from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser for 120 days and censures Westmark. (Rel. IA-1117)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST JAMES SIMPSON, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on May 5 U.S. District Court Judge Rudy Lozano, Northern District of Indiana, entered Orders of Permanent Injunction against James Simpson, Donald Swanson, Certified Investment Companies, Certified Commodities, Inc., Certified Precious Metals, Inc., and Levitan Investment Management Corp. An Order of Preliminary Injunction was also entered against Richard Holiusa. Each Order was entered following the defendants' consent. The Orders enjoin the defendants from violating the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws, freezes their assets, and requires them to disgorge such funds as the court may order.

The Complaint alleged that as part of a fraudulent scheme, the defendants offered and sold unregistered securities and misrepresented to investors that the proceeds would be used to purchase certain assets. In fact, no such assets were purchased. The Complaint also alleged that the defendants made other material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the returns to be expected and the risks associated with the investments. A Temporary Restraining Order was entered against defendants on April 25. (SEC v. James Simpson, et al., NDIN, No. H88-0212). (LR-11744)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

VESTAR, INC.

An order of temporary exemption and a notice of application have been issued. The notice gives interested persons until June 10 to request a hearing on an application filed by Vestar, Inc., a Delaware corporation, for a permanent order declaring that it is primarily engaged in a business or businesses other than that of investing, reinvesting, owning, holding, or trading in securities or, in the alternative, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act from November 12, 1987 to the earlier to occur of November 12, 1988, or the next public offering of any class of its securities. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 13 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell from time to time through December 31, 1991 up to one million shares of its authorized but unissued common stock, no par value (Additional Common Stock), to participants in National's Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan, as amended (New Plan). The New Plan will provide that cash dividends and optional cash payments of participating shareholders who elect to reinvest in National's common stock will be reinvested, at National's option, through open market purchases of National's common stock, and/or in Additional Common Stock. National has been authorized, by order contained in this notice, to mail to eachholder of record of National's common stock a prospectus and an authorization form with respect to the proposed transaction. APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-30) that provides for the professional execution of limit orders above 600 shares delivered to its specialists over the PACE system. (Rel. 34-25716); and The Midwest Clearing Corporation and the Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MCC-87-6 and SR-MSTC-87-7) to allow them to provide a new computer-to-computer communications link, or File Transmission Service, between the MCC/MSTC computer and their participants' computers. (Rel. 34-25718)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-12) that extends its stock option near-term expiration pilot program, which provides for four expiration months, including two near-term months, to December 31, 1988.
