COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC AND FHLBB JOINTLY ISSUE REPORT ON AMERICAN SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF FLORIDA

Today the Commission and the Federal Home Loan Bank Board jointly published a report of investigation concerning certain public statements made by American Savings and Loan Association of Florida, a federally-insured savings and loan association in Miami. ASLA's public statements concerned its 1984 leveraged repurchase transactions totalling nearly \$1 billion involving E.S.M. Government Securities, Inc. E.S.M. collapsed in March 1985. The Report discusses the duty of issuers to disclose material contingencies under the reporting and antifraud provisions. Specifically, the Report states that if a future occurrence implicates the loss of an appreciable percentage of the corporation's assets or a significant reduction of the corporation's equity, disclosure may be required even if the event is not certain to occur nor even highly probable. In addition, the Report states that in the view of the Commission and the FHLBB, ASLA's unsecured position of approximately \$100 million resulting from these transactions should have been disclosed. In the view of the two agencies, the mere publication of the dollar amounts in the transactions, without full disclosure of the risks involved, failed to satisfy th applicable provisions of the securities laws. ASLA consented to the Report, without admitting or denying any statements or conclusions therein. (Rel. 34-25788; AAER-194)

CHA CONTRACTOR BUT

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES W. STREICHER BARRED

Chief Administrative Law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision barring Charles W. Streicher, formerly associated with E.S.M. Government Securities, Inc., of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, from asosication with a broker or dealer.

Judge Blair found that Streicher had been (1) convicted on January 26, 1987 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida on one count of conspiracy and one count of mail fraud; (2) convicted on May 5, 1986 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio on two counts of wire fraud; and (3) convicted on May 5, 1986 in the Court of Common Pleas, Hamilton County, Ohio, on three counts of grand theft. In addition, Streicher was found to have been permanently enjoined on September 30, 1986 by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities acts in the offer and sale of U.S. Government or U.S. Government-guaranteed securities, or any other security of any issuer.

FINDINGS AND ORDER ENTERED AGAINST YORK RESEARCH CORPORATION

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against York Research Corporation, a Delaware corporation, to determine whether York failed to comply with disclosure obligations under the reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. The Order Instituting Proceedings and an Opinion and Order allege that York violated such provisions by filing periodic reports on Forms 10-K and 10-Q which misrepresented or omitted material information. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement in which York, without admitting or denying the allegations and findings contained therein, consented to an Order providing for findings that York failed to include in its periodic reports information necessary to make the statements made not misleading, that York's periodic filings misrepresented or omitted material information regarding its primary subsidiary's prior failures to obtain adequate financing, industry experience, business prospects, and the existence of key employees and ordering York to comply in all material respects with Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-1, and 13a-13. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KEYSTONE PROVIDENT LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Keystone Provident Life Insurance Company, et al., for an order exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit Applicants to offer their shares to affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies in conjunction with variable annuity contracts and variable life insurance contracts.
