COMMISSION RELEASES CHAIRMAN'S SPEECH

The Commission today released remarks being made by David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, on corporate issues before the 1988 Conference of the American Society of Corporate Secretaries.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED FROM JOSEPH T. CUSACK

The New York Regional Office announced that, in administrative proceedings ordered pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Joseph T. Cusack has submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission has accepted.

Cusack, without admitting or denying the allegations, allowed the Commission to find that from June 1984 to about June 1986, Cusack: (1) aided and abetted Cusack Light & Co., Inc.'s (Registrant), a registered broker-dealer, violations of various back office provisions of the Act; (2) was enjoined by a federal district court from further violations of various securities laws; and (3) was responsible for the need of an appointment of a trustee to liquidate Registrant. Cusack consented to a bar from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-25812)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

APPLICATION FOR ATTORNEY FEES FROM ASSETS OF SHEPPARD RESOURCES, INC. AND PILGRIM VENTURE CORP. DENIED

The Chicago Regional Office announed that on May 32 the Honorable Nicholas J. Bua denied an Application for Attorney Fees filed by counsel representing certain purported officers and directors of defendant corporations, Sheppard Resources, Inc. (Sheppard) and Pilgrim Venture Corp. (Pilgrim). The Application requested payment of the fees from assets of Sheppard and Pilgrim which were frozen by earlier court order. In denying the Application, the Court found that, although counsel's clients were listed as officers and directors of Sheppard and Pilgrim, in their Form S-18 registration statements and Forms 10-Q and 10-K filings, these individuals lacked the authority to act on behalf of their respective companies and, therefore, had no basis for asserting any authority over the corporations' funds. Further, the court found that these individuals simply acted as a shield behind which the actual operatives for Sheppard and Pilgrim engaged in fraudulent securities transactions and that they possessed neither <u>de jure</u> nor <u>de facto</u> authority to retain counsel for the companies.

The complaint and other pleadings had alleged that the registration statements filed on behalf of Sheppard and Pilgrim contained forged signatures of these purported officers and directors and failed to disclose, among other things, that defendants Carl Porto and Charles Scheurerman had, in fact, controlled the companies.
