CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST MALCOLM KANAN

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on June 21 U.S. District Court Judge Philip M. Pro, District of Nevada, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Malcolm Kanan, permanently enjoining him from further violations of the registration provisions of the securities laws. Kanan, without admitting or denying the facts alleged, consented to the Order.

The November 14, 1986 Complaint alleged that from January to September 1982, Kanan sold 55,000 shares of the unregistered common stock of Emervac Corporation. (SEC v. Dennis A. Thomas, et al., D. Nev., Civil Action No. S-86-1093 PMP, filed November 14, 1986). (LR-11783)
