U.S. SECURITES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

DECISION MADE ON FOIA REQUEST BY JOSEPH D. CARNEY

The Commission sent a letter to Joseph D. Carney granting, in part, and denying, in part, his request for reconsideration of a confidential treatment appeal. (FOIA-89)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

JOHN A. GRANT BARRED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under Section 15(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against John A. Grant of Boston, Massachusetts. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Grant's Offer of Settlement in which he, without admitting or denying the allegations and findings contained therein, consented to a bar from association with any broker or dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer.

The Commission found that on May 31 Grant was permanently enjoined from further violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 in SEC v. John Grant, D. Mass., Civ. Action No. 88-1209-MA. The Complaint alleged that Grant sold over \$5.5 million in unregistered securities in the form of promissory notes, misrepresented and failed to apprise investors of the risks associated with their investment, misappropriated investors' funds by transferring them to various accounts under his control without their authorization and, on several occasions, used proceeds from the sale of notes to pay interest and principal on previously issued notes. ORDER AND FINDINGS ISSUED AGAINST GERALD L. ZAIDMAN

The Commission issued an Order and Findings under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Gerald L. Zaidman. Zaidman was president and chief financial officer in 1984 of Windsor Industries, Inc., now known as Windsor Holding Corp. The Commission found that Zaidman was a cause of Windsor's failure to maintain adequate internal accounting controls as a result of his failure to take steps to cure Windsor's control deficiencies concerning inventory and cash receipts and disbursements. The Commission also found that Zaidman was a cause of Windsor's filing a false and misleading report on Form 10-Q in November 1984 as a result of his failure to take sufficient steps upon learning that the company's financial statements may have been overstated.

Zaidman consented to the Order without admitting or denying any matters therein. Zaidman was ordered to take steps to effect compliance with Sections 13(a) and 13(b) (2)(B) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20 and 13a-13. (Rel. 34-25930)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

GEORGE F. PAVARINI PLEADS GUILTY

The U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York and the New York Regional Office announced that on July 18 George F. Pavarini of Scarsdale, New York pled guilty to a two-count Information filed in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. The Information charged mail fraud and failure to register as an investment adviser.

The Information alleges that Pavarini, an attorney, formed Pavtec Hedge Fund in 1981 to buy and sell securities of his choosing. He did not register as an adviser. Beginning in 1982, Pavarini defrauded investors in Pavtec by sending them newsletters and account statements detailing profits of the Fund when the Fund was in fact losing money. Based upon the newsletters and account statements, additional monies were invested. Pavarini redeemed the investments of limited partners by using currently incoming money from investors and money entrusted to him by law clients. The Information also alleges that approximately 290 investors had invested over \$3,300,000 and that approximately \$188,000 in fund assets remain. (U.S. v. George F. Pavarini, SDNY, 88 Cr. 445). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ASTROP FAMILY OF FUNDS TRUST

An order has been issued declaring that Astrop Family of Funds Trust has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16489 - July 21)

AHA INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC.

An order has been issued exempting AHA Investment Funds, Inc. from certain provisions of Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 18f-2 and granting exemption from certain disclosure requirements set forth in Rules 20a-2(a)(1), 20a-2(b)(1), 20a-2(a)(8), 20a-2(a)(9), and 20a-2(b)(4), Items 5(b)(iii) and 16(a)(iii) of Form N-1A, and Items 47 through 52 and 72(f) of Form N-SAR, and Sections 6-07.2(a), (b), and (c) of Regulation S-X as it pertains to registered investment companies. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SYSTEM ENERGY RESOURCES, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until August 15 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24684, dated July 21: SYSTEM ENERGY RESOURCES, INC. (SERI) - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to extend, from August 31, 1988 to February 28, 1989, its Restated and Amended Fuel Lease with Port Gibson Energy, Inc. under which SERI leases from Port Gibson the nuclear fuel used to satisfy a portion of the fuel requirements of Unit No. 1 at SERI's Grand Gulf Nuclear Generating Station. In addition, SERI will acknowledge notice and consent to Port Gibson entering into an Amendment to the Restated and Amended Credit Agreement with many banks which will extend the expiration date to February 28, 1989 and which consent is required by the Fuel Lease.
