### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

MARK D. FITTERMAN AND EDWIN H. NORDLINGER NAMED MERITORIOUS EXECUTIVES BY PRESIDENT REAGAN

The Commission announced today that Mark D. Fitterman and Edwin H. Nordlinger have received the Presidential Rank Award of Meritorious Executive. The Meritorious Executive Award recognizes senior managers in government service who have made exceptional contributions to the agencies for which they work. Managers are nominated by the agencies, recommended by the Office of Personnel Management, and selected by President Reagan.

## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF WILLIAM A. CALVO, III ORDERED

The Commission temporarily suspended William A. Calvo, III, an attorney, from appearing or practicing before the Commission under Rule 2(e)(3) of its Rules of Practice. The suspension is based on a permanent injunction entered against Calvo for violations of the securities laws by the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut on June 8 in SEC v. The Electronics Warehouse, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. H-86-282. Calvo may file a petition with the Commission to lift the suspension within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension. If no such petition is filed, the suspension becomes permanent. (Rel. 34-25946)

### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

#### LIMITED PARTNERSHIPS PROMOTERS ENJOINED

The Houston Branch Office announced that on July 26 U.S. District Judge Edward C. Prado, Western District of Texas, entered orders of permanent injunction against Magan's Superbred Racehorses, Inc., Wilco's Data, Inc., War Hymn Associates, War Eagle Associates, and John Joseph Magan, all of San Antonio, Texas. Defendants were permanently enjoined from further violations of the securities registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933. Defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

The June 21 Complaint alleges that, beginning in at least May 1988 and continuing thereafter, defendants have been offering unregistered securities in the form of interests in limited partnerships organized to breed and raise standardbred harness racehroses. According to the Complaint, defendants offered these unregistered securities through at least eight advertisements being aired on local and national television stations and cable networks which service areas in Texas and Oklahoma. It further alleges that the defendants made untrue statements of material facts and omitted to state material facts concerning, among other things, the risks and returns associated with the securities. (SEC v. Magan's Superbred Racehorses, Inc., et al., WDTX, Civil Action No. SA 88 CA 0626). (LR-11823)

#### SHELL COMPANY PROMOTERS SUED

The Fort Worth Regional Office filed a civil action on July 25 against First Houston Capital Resources Fund, Inc., Agalod, Inc., W. Allen Broughton, Donald D. Howard, Michael A. Light, Michael F. Dermer, James Johnson, Nicholas A. Genco, and Arnold Campos. The action seeks injunctive relief against them to prevent further violations of the securities registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and disgorgement from Agalod, Light, and Dermer.

The Complaint alleges that Agalod, Light, and Dermer, of Miami, Florida, arranged a business combination between First Houston and a Utah shell company and, with Broughton and Howard, both of Fort Worth, Texas, created an active, public over-the-counter trading market for the survivor's shares through the dissemination of false and misleading releases and financial statements. Johnson, an NASD registered representative, sold First Houston shares and prepared his own false and misleading releases. Genco and Campos provided unqualified audit opinions on false financial statements to aid and abet the other defendants in the scheme. (SEC v. First Houston Capital Resources Fund, Inc., et al., USDC NDTX, CA 4-88-475-E). (LR-11825)

An order has been issued requesting approval of certain offers of exchange by the following: Van Kampen Merritt U.S. Government Fund, Van Kampen Merritt Insured Tax Free Income Fund, Van Kampen Merritt Tax Free High Income Fund, Van Kampen Merritt California Insured Tax Free Fund, Van Kampen Merritt Growth and Income Fund, and Van Kampen Merritt Pennsylvania Tax Free Income Fund (the Load Funds); Van Kampen Merritt Money Market Fund and Van Kampen Merritt Tax Free Money Fund (the No Load Funds); Van Kampen Merritt Inc. (VKM) and any additional open-end funds in the same family for which VKM or one of its subsidiaries or a subsidiary under common control as defined in Section 2(a)(9) of the Investment Company Act will serve as principal underwriter or investment adviser in the future (Additional Funds). #### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

#### APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A CLEARING AGENCY

Delta Government Options Corp. filed an application for full registration as a clearing agency under Section 17A of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Delta would issue and trade options on U.S. government securities and provide clearance and settlement services with respect to those options. Under Section 17A(b)(1) of the Act, Delta has requested several exemptions from the requirements of Section 17A. (Rel. 34-25956)
