U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

REGISTRATION OF ITEC SECURITIES CORPORATION REVOKED; MARTIN M. PINNAS BARRED

The Commission issued an order instituting public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against ITEC Securities Corporation, a registered broker-dealer located in Bouston, Texas, and Martin M. Pinnas. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted their Offers of Settlement in which they, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to findings of violations of the sanctions imposed.

On the basis of the Order for Proceedings and the Offers of Settlement, the Commission found that: (1) Respondents willfully violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act in connection with their sale of securities in the form of promissory notes; and (2) Pinnas had been enjoined by consent from engaging in the violations just described.

Based on the above findings and the Offers of Settlement, ITEC's registration as a broker-dealer was revoked and Pinnas was barred from association with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-26014)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND BANKING GROUP LIMITED

An amended order has been issued exempting Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the offer and sale of its equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-16537 - Aug. 26)

NATIONAL LIQUID RESERVES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by Smith Barney, Harris Upham & Co. Incorporated, National Liquid Reserves, Inc. and other funds (Funds) advised by Smith, Barney Advisers, Inc., and Mutual Management Corp. (Advisers) for an order exempting the Funds and the Advisers from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Funds to reimburse the Advisers for costs incurred under an interim advisory contract entered into without shareholder approval. period through December 31, 1991; and <u>VERMONT YANKEE NUCLEAR POWER CORPORATION</u> - subsidiary of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, to issue and sell to Marine Midland Bank, N.A. up to \$10.5 million aggregate principal amount of its short-term promissory notes to finance the fabrication and installation costs of an Emergency Response Facility Information System.
