COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

General Counsel Daniel L. Goelzer announced today that, at the invitation of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, the Commission filed a friend-of-the-court brief in Adena Exploration, Inc. v. Dave Sylvan. In that appeal, Adena challenges a district court's determination that it sold a security in the form of a "fractional undivided interest in oil, gas, or other mineral rights." The Commission's brief takes the position that such an interest is a "security" within the Securities Act definitional language where it has the characteristics typically associated with such an interest. The brief states that the plain language of the Securities Act, principles of statutory construction articulated by the Supreme Court in Landreth Timber Co. v. Landreth, 471 U.S. 681 (1985), and the Act's statutory scheme compel this conclusion. (Press Release 88-76)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RICHARD L. SAWYER SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Richard L. Sawyer of San Diego, California. Sawyer was a former principal of Colorado Planning Associates, Inc., a defunct Denver, Colorado corporation. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Sawyer's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that a permanent injunction was entered on November 24, 1987 against Sawyer enjoining him from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint in the injunctive action alleged, among other things, that Sawyer and others made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the diversion of investor proceeds to the personal use of Sawyer and others, and the safety and source of the investments made on behalf of the investors. The Commission's Order provided that Sawyer be permanently barred from any association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer. MICHAEL K. THOMAS SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Michael R. Thomas of Chandler, Arizona. Thomas was a former principal of Colorado Planning Associates, Inc., a defunct Denver, Colorado corporation. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Thomas's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found in its order that a permanent injunction was entered on December 9, 1987 against Thomas enjoining him from future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions and from aiding and abetting violations of the broker-dealer provisions of the securities laws. The Complaint in the injunctive action alleged, among other things, that Thomas and others made material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the diversion of investor proceeds to the personal use of Thomas and others, and the safety and source of the investments made on behalf of the investors. The Commission's Order provided that Thomas be permanently barred from any association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JERALD MOSKOWITZ ENJOINED

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that on August 17 Judge Alexander Harvey II, U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining Jerald Moskowitz, of Scarsdale, New York, from future violations of the antifraud, Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, and the periodic reporting provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. As a result of settlement negotiations, Moskowitz consented to the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint.

The April 9, 1987 Complaint alleged that Moskowitz, one-time president of Psych Systems, Inc. (PSI), and two other defendants were involved in a scheme at PSI to improperly recognize and report revenue in 1983. As a result, it was alleged that PSI's revenue was overstated by \$1,060,000 for the 1983 fiscal year. The Complaint further alleged that Moskowitz and the other defendants misled Alexander Grant & Co. during its audit of PSI. The Commission 's action is continuing against the remaining defendant, Lee Richards. (SEC v. Jerald Moskowitz, et al., DMD, Civil Action No. H-87-862). (LR-11849)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

IMPERIAL PORTFOLIOS, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Imperial Portfolios, Inc. from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit it to impose deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares of its High Yield Investment Fund. (Rel. IC-16542 - Aug. 30)
