ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

Marianne Smythe, Associate Director of the Commission's Division of Investment Management, will testify before the Energy and Power Subcommittee of the Energy and Commerce Committee of the House of Representatives on Wednesday, September 14. Subject will be the role of independent power producers and the possible need to amend the Public Utility Holding Company Act (administered by the Commission). The hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. in Room 2218, Rayburn House Office Building.

## **CORPORATE REORGANIZATION RELEASES**

BRIEF FILED IN BANKRUPTCY REORGANIZATION CASE

On August 31, the Solicitor General of the United States filed a brief in the Supreme Court on behalf of the Commission, in its statutory role as advisor in reorganization cases under 11 U.S.C. 1109(a), in a bankruptcy reorganization case, <u>Sheftelman v.</u> <u>Stan- dard Metals Corp</u>. The petitioner in the Supreme Court, a purchaser of industrial revenue bonds, seeks a writ of certiorari to review a decision by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit, holding that the filing of a class proof of claim is not permissible in bankruptcy. The brief for the Commission argues that the Tenth Circuit's ruling is incorrect -- that, under the Bankruptcy Code and Rules, class proofs of claim are permissible in bankruptcy proceedings. For several reasons, however, the brief concludes that certiorari should not be granted in this case. (Sheftelman v. Standard Metals Corp., 88-243, S. Ct.) (Rel. CR-379)

### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MOHD A. ASLAMI ENJOINED, ORDERED TO PAY DISGORGEMENT AND PENALTY

> The Boston Regional Office announced on August ? the entry of an Order by the Western Section of the U.S. District Court for the District of Massachusetts enjoining Mohd Aslami from future violations of the antifraud and beneficial ownership reporting provisions of the securities laws and ordering Aslami to pay \$58,540 disgorgement and an Insider Trading Sanctions Act penalty of \$58,540. The Complaint alleged insider trading and reporting violations by Aslami, a former executive vice president of SpecTran Corporation. It also alleged that Aslami sold 20,000 shares of SpecTran's stock just prior to news announcements by SpecTran that it would suffer substantial losses in revenue for that quarter. Aslami, in a Stipulation and Consent filed along with the Complaint, agreed to pay \$117,080 which represents the loss that he avoided by selling the stock before the bad news announcements and a penalty for selling the stock. Aslami consented to a permanent injunction against him without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations. (SEC v. Mohd A. Aslami, No. 88-0096-XX, D. Mass.) (LR-11858)

ORAL FINDINGS RENDERED AGAINST LEONARD C. ZRNIC IN INJUNCTION CASE

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on August 25 Judge Justin L. Quackenbush rendered oral findings of fact against Leonard C. Zrnic. Zrnic is a defendant in <u>SEC</u> <u>v. Golden Bear Resources, Ltd.</u>, in the Eastern District of Washington at Spokane. Zrnic had been charged with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Judge stated that he would enter a judgment of permanent injunction against Zrnic.

Judge Quackenbush found that Zrnic violated the law by making false statements to brokers and investors about Golden Bear Resources, Ltd., a British Columbia corporation which at the time was traded on the Vancouver (B.C.) Stock Exchange. The false statements included assertions that Golden Bear had acquired oil production property in Alaska and was preparing to drill on the property in a joint venture with major oil companies. Zrnic also falsely represented that Golden Bear stock would quadruple in value within a three month period. The Judge further found that Zrnic manipulated the price of Golden Bear stock by placing a series of false "buy" orders at a Spokane broker-dealer. These orders helped move the stock price upward, which enticed investors into the market. Zrnic never paid for the orders, and the Judge found that Zrnic never intended to pay for them. (SEC v. Golden Bear Resources, Ltd., et al., No. C86-736-JLQ, EDWA). (LR-11861)

### **CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS**

MICHAEL DAVID SENTENCED

The New York Regional Office announced that on August 9 Michael David was sentenced to four months imprisonment and four years probation. The sentences were imposed with respect to David's November 1986 guilty pleas to an indictment charging him with conspiracy, securities fraud, mail fraud, and obstruction of an SEC investigation in connection with his disseminating material nonpublic information to others concerning takeover matters involving clients of the law firm at which David was an associate. (U.S. v. Michael David, 86 Cr. 4543, SDNY 1986, JFK). (LR-11863)

FIRST INVESTORS OPTION FUND, INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by First Investors Option Fund, Inc. (Option Fund), First Investors High Yield Fund, Inc. (High Yield Fund), First Investors Corporation, and First Investors Periodic Payment Plans for Investment in Shares of First Investors Option Fund, Inc. (Plan) granting exemption and approval for the proposed exchange of, and the resulting substitution of, shares of High Yield Fund for the shares of Option Fund as the underlying investment for the Plan, and certain affiliated transactions in connection therewith. #### PAINEWEBBER AMERICA FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by PaineWebber America Fund, PaineWebber Atlas Fund, PaineWebber California Tax-Exempt Income Fund, PaineWebber Cashfund, Inc., PaineWebber Fixed Income Portfolios, PaineWebber Investment Series, PaineWebber Master Series, Inc., PaineWebber Municipal Series, PaineWebber Olympus Fund, PaineWebber RMA Money Fund, Inc., PaineWebber RMA Tax-Free Fund, Inc., PaineWebber Series Trust, PaineWebber Tax-Exempt Income Fund and all future investment companies for which PaineWebber Incorporated or Mitchell Hutchins Asset Management Inc. serves as investment adviser (Applicants) for an order exempting Applicants from the provisions of Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act. #### CHARTER NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until October 3 to request a hearing on proposals by the following companies filed under Release 35-24710, dated September 8: <u>MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES INC.</u> - a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company and New Orleans Public Service Inc. for SERI to provide alternative collateral, for the pollution control revenue bonds that Claiborne County, Mississippi issued to finance pollution control facilities. SERI's obligations with respect to such collateral might, under certain circumstances, be secured by assignment of certain rights under an Availability Agreement with SERI's associate electric utility companies and under a Capital Funds Agreement with Middle South; and <u>NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM (NEES)</u> - a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Granite State Electric company, Massachusetts Electric Company, The Narragansett Electric Company, NEES Energy, Incorporated, New England Electric Transmission Corporation, New England Power Service Company, whereby the companies seek separate authority to issue shortterm notes to the NEES Money Pool and/or banks, to issue and sell commercial paper, and to acquire short term notes, through October 31, 1990; and, to issue up to an October 31, 1990.
