ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ANTHONY J. BUTTIMER BARRED

The Commission instituted public proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Anthony J. Buttimer, formerly associated with a registered broker-dealer. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Buttimer's Offer of Settlement in which, without admitting or denying the Commission's Findings, except for the finding that on August 4 he was permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws [SEC v. Anthony J. Buttimer, USDC NDGA, Civil Action No. 1:88-CV-1675-MHS], he consented to an order permanently barring him from association with any broker or dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser.

In the Order, the Commission found that Buttimer, associated with various broker-dealers from approximately April 1969 to approximately July 1986, willfully violated the antifraud provisions by: obtaining approximately \$600,000 from 17 investors for various fictitious investments based upon false representations of high returns and the use of investors' funds; misappropriating and converting investors' funds to his own personal use; and lulling investors by making misrepresentations and omissions of material fact to investors concerning the success of the investments and issuing notes to them representing their initial investments and purported profits. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SUMMARY JUDGMENT GRANTED AGAINST CARL LEO KARCHER

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on September 12 the Commission's motion for summary judgment against Carl Leo Karcher, filed in the federal district court in Los Angeles, was granted. Judge Edward Rafeedie found that Karcher was an insider of Carl Karcher Enterprises, Inc. (CKE), that he sold CKE securities while in possession of adverse material nonpublic information concerning CKE, that he acted with scienter, that he accordingly violated the antifraud provisions, and that there was a reasonable likelihood of a recurrence of the violation. The Court permanently enjoined Karcher from further fraud violations and ordered that he disgorge \$10,500, representing the full amount alleged by the Commission to represent losses avoided by the illegal securities sales, plus interest. The Court declined to assess penalties under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. The Court also denied Karcher's cross-motion for a summary judgment. The case respecting the other defendants is pending. (SEC v. Carl N. Karcher, et al., Civil Action No. 88-2021-ER, Tx, CDCA). (LR-11865)

SYSTEMATIC PLANS TO ACCUMULATE SHARES OF INDUSTRIES TREND FUND, INC.
