RULES AND RELATED NEACHENE COMMISSION

COMMENTS REQUESTED ON PROPOSED RULES 203(b)(1)-1 AND 203(b)(3)-2

The Comission is proposing for public comment Rules 203(b)(1)-1 and 203(b)(3)-2 under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. The proposed rules would exempt from federal registration under the Act certain small advisers registered in each state in which they do business who, among other things, have a limited number of clients and funds under management. The Commission is also proposing to relieve advisers exempt under these rules from the Act's recordkeeping rule, advertising rule, cash solicitation rule, disciplinary disclosure rule, and the Act's restrictions on principal and agency cross transactions.

Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan A. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Stop 6-9, Washington, DC 20549.
