SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

EXTENSION OF COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED RULE CHANGE.

The Commission extended the comment period on a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-19) that would establish a new quotation service, the OTC Bulletin Board Display Service, for OTC securities that are not included in the NASDAQ System nor listed on a national securities exchange. AMENDMENT OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed Amendment No. 1 to a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-84-10) that would amend Appendix F to Article III, Section 34 of its Rules of Fair Practice, to allow for the receipt by broker-dealers of indeterminate compensation in connection with the sale of direct participation programs. [Notice of the original filing was given by Release 34-21468, November 11, 1984, and by publication in the Federal Register, 49 FR 44966, November 13, 1984.] (Rel. 34-26192)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-33) to expand and extend its Automated Options Market (AUTOM) system pilot program. (Rel. 34-26193); The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-17) that would amend its arbitration procedures to conform with recently approved amendments to the Uniform Code of Arbitration as adopted by the Securities Industry Conference on arbitration. (Rel. 34-26194); The Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-87-11) that would delete in its entirety MSE Rule 6.01, Article III, which generally prohibits bank or bank holding company ownership of MSE members or member organizations.
