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# COMMISSION ANNOU

PUBLIC REFERENCE NEW RULES TO BECOME EFFECTIVE

As previously announced, the Commission is in the process of reorganization of its Public Reference Room, to balance the needs of disparate groups of users of the facility. As part of that reorganization, new operating rules and procedures have been developed for those using the room, and existing carrel space has been reallocated, to achieve a balance between the needs of regular and of occasional users. Both the new rules and new carrel assignments will be effective as of November 14. Those affected by carrel re-assignments have been notified by letter. Copies of the rules are available from the Public Reference Room or from the Office of Public Affairs.

#### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JOE FREE ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on October 24 a Final Judgment was entered by consent against Joe Free, the last remaining defendant in the Commission's civil action against Laser Arms Corporation and others. The Judgment permanently enjoined Free from violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws. The Commission alleged in its Complaint that Free, who provided public relations services for Laser Arms under the alias Brian Andrews, made false and misleading statements about a self-chilling can which Laser Arms was purportedly developing and about purported patents and contracts pertaining to the can. (SEC v. Laser Arms Corporation, et al., USDC SDNY, Docket No. 86 Civ. 3414, WCC). (LR-11902)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T.H. LEE ACQUISITION FUND II, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by T.H. Lee Acquisition Fund II, L.P., T.H. Lee Acquisition Fund (Retirement Accounts) II, L.P. (collectively, Partnerships), and Thomas H. Lee Advisors II, L.P. (Adviser) for an order determining that (a) the Independent General Partners of the Partnerships are not "interested persons," within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, of the Partnerships, or the Adviser, and (b) limited partners who own less than 5% equity interest in a Partnership will not be deemed "affiliated persons" (as defined by Section 2(a)(3)(D) of the Partnership or other partners solely by reason of being limited of the Act) of the Partnership or other partners solely by reason of being limited partners. ## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Mississippi Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell through March 31, 1989 up to \$20 million of preferred stock. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the issuance and sale of up to \$40 million of first mortgage bonds pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-24732 - Oct. 21)

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Granite State Electric Company, Massachusetts Electric Company, The Narragansett Electric Company, NEES Energy, Incorporated, New England Electric Transmission Corporation, New England Energy Incorporated, New England Hydro-Transmission Electric Company, Inc., New England Hydro-Transmission Corporation, New England Power Company, and New England Power Service Company, whereby the companies seek separate authority to issue short-term notes to the NEES Money Pool and/or banks, to issue and sell commercial paper, and to acquire short-term notes, through October 31, 1990.
