#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER DENYING ACCESS

The General Counsel sent a letter to Samuel Schulman, in response to his appeal under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), denying access to the confidential portions of an Exhibit to a Form 10-Q filed in 1985 by Twentieth Century-Fox Film Corporation. These confidential portions consist of the specific terms as to royalty rates and distribution fees contained in a partnership agreement between CBS, Inc. and Fox regarding the formation and operation of the CBS/FOX Company. The General Counsel determined that this information is exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 4, which protects matters that are "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged and confidential. ## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST JOHN J. CONNOLLY

The Commission instituted an administrative proceeding under Sections 15(b)(6) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 charging that on June 14 John J. Connolly, a registered representative residing in Staten Island, New York, was permanently enjoined by Order of U.S. District Judge David N. Edelstein, Southern District of New York, in SEC v. Cymaticolor Corporation, et al. [84 Civ. 4508 (DNE)], from violating Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Complaint alleges that between 1981 and 1982, Connolly violated securities laws in connection with the sale of Cymaticolor stock and, from 1984 through 1987, he engaged in a free-riding stock trading scheme that included the use of nominee accounts opened in the names of fictitious individuals. Connolly consented to the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations.

Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Connolly's offer of settlement in which he consented to being barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser, with a right to reapply for association in three years. The Commission's bar is effective immediately. (Rel. 34-26270)

# **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

BULLOCK MONTHLY INCOME SHARES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 9 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bullock Monthly Income Shares, Inc. for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16635 - Nov. 15)

# HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

A supplemental notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 5 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following company filed under Release 35-24745, dated November 10: MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC. - a registered holding company, its wholly-owned subsidiary, System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), and Middle South's other electric utility subsidiaries, Arkansas Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company, and New Orleans Public Service, Inc., for SERI to sell and leaseback approximately 10-15% of its 90% undivided ownership interest in Unit 1 of the Grand Gulf Steam Electric Generating Station. In order to provide security for its reimbursements obligations under a Reimbursement Agreement, SERI will assign certain rights under an Availability Agreement with its associate electric utility companies and under a Capital Funds Agreement with Middle South. Both the Electric Utility Subsidiaries and Middle South propose to consent to and join in such assignment.

## **SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS**

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange filed the following proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: (SR-NYSE-88-32) to adopt a new specialist allocation policy. (Rel. 34-26277); and (SR-NYSE-88-33) that would prohibit for six months the allocation of new listings to specialist units subject to disciplinary or performance improvement actions or to specialist units that voluntarily withdraw their registration in securities due to impending disciplinary or performance improvement actions.
