POLICY STATEMENT ON REGULATION OF INTERNATIONAL SECURITIES MARKETS

On November 14, the Commission released a policy statement on regulation of international securities markets. The statement, unanimously approved by the Commission, was delivered by David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, to the International Association of Securities Commissioners' Annual Meeting in Melbourne, Australia on November 15, 1988. Comments were requested.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE CARDINAL FUND INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Cardinal Fund Inc., Cardinal Government Securities Trust, Cardinal Tax Exempt Money Trust, Cardinal Government Guaranteed Fund, and The Ohio Company requesting an order approving certain offers of exchange to be made on a basis other than the relative net asset values of the shares to be exchanged. ARKANSAS POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Arkansas Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to amend its nuclear fuel leasing agreement, and to consent to a related credit agreement. (Rel. 35-24746 - Nov. 14)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

An order has been issued on a proposal by Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, (or, in the case of shares purchased on the open market, to purchase and sell) under its Dividend Reinvestment and Common Share Purchase Plan, from time to time up to December 31, 1990, the 148,630 common shares remaining from the three million shares previously authorized to be issued and sold under the Plan [Rel. 35-24087, May 6, 1986], and no more than 800,000 additional common shares. GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to effect a series of transactions whereby Oglethorpe Power Corporation would acquire an interest, increasing over time, in Georgia Power's Rocky Mountain Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project. (Rel. 35-24748 - Nov. 17)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted partial accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-37) to implement for a one-year period auxiliary closing procedures to handle order flow during monthly expirations of derivative index products. (Rel. 34-26293)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-44) to increase the minimum and maximum annual fees paid by issuers of securities included in the NASDAQ system. (Rel. 34-26294)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
