COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

STUDY BY THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ECONOMIST RELEASED

The Office of the Chief Economist of the Commission today published a study entitled, "Do Bad Bidders Make Good Targets?"

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DAVID S. BOWEN ENJOINED

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on November 14 David S. Bowen, of Charleston, West Virginia, and president of Colonial International Import, Ltd., was permanently enjoined by Judge Justin L. Quackenbush, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Washington, from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The injunction was entered with Bowen's consent and without his either admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. The Complaint alleged violations of the securities laws by Bowen, Colonial, and others through sham public distributions of securities and misrepresentations.

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY; NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED

The proceeds of NATIONAL's borrowings would be made available to the subsidiaries through the Money Pool from January 1, 1989 through December 31, 1989; and NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED - subsidiary of New England Electric System, to contribute up to \$40 million to its partnership with Samedan Oil Corporation, subsidiary of Noble Affiliates, Inc., a nonaffiliate company, during 1989 for exploration and development of oil and gas prospects initiated prior to December 31, 1986.
