ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST JACK D. PROSEN

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Jack D. Prosen, a registered representative and registered investment adviser located in Canoga Park, California. Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, Prosen consented to the sanctions imposed by the Commission.

The Order finds that Prosen was enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington on November 16, 1988, prohibiting future violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Complaint arose out of Prosen's sale of secured promissory notes intended to provide financing for Pulsar Oil and Gas,

Inc., a public company. The Complaint alleged that the notes were not registered with the Commission, and that Prosen omitted to disclose material information concerning the issuer of the notes and related entities, and the collateral securing the notes. The Order suspends Prosen from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, or municipal securities dealer for 60 days. It also revokes his investment adviser registration and bars him from association with any investment adviser, with a right to reapply in both capacities after two years. (Rel. 34-26335)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DEFENDANTS CONSENT TO FRAUDULENT FINANCING SCHEME

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on November 16 District Court Judge Barbara Rothstein in Seattle, Washington entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Gary A. Kaku, of San Diego, California, and Jack D. Prosen, of Canoga Park, California, for violations of the securities laws in connection with the offer and sale of securities of Pulsar Oil & Gas, Inc., a Washington corporation, and related entities.

The Injunctions restrain Kaku from further sale of unregistered limited partnership interests designed to finance new Pulsar acquisitions, and Prosen from further sale of unregistered secured promissory notes issued by Pulsar's president, Robert L. Middleton, for the same purpose. Both defendants consented to the Injunctions without admitting or denying the allegations. (SEC v. Pulsar Oil and Gas, Inc., et al., C87-1362, USDC WDWA). (LR-11934)

FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST ENCIBAR, INC.

The Denver Regional Office announced that on November 7 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Order against Encibar, Inc. of Encinitos, California. The Judgment restrains and enjoins Encibar from failing to file timely periodic reports and Notifications of Late Filing, and requires it to file certain delinquent reports.

In its Complaint originally filed September 22, 1987 and later amended, the Commission alleged that Encibar failed to file its Annual Reports on Forms 10-K for its fiscal years ended March 31, 1986, March 31, 1987 and March 31, 1988, and its Quarterly Reports on Forms 10-Q for its fiscal quarters ended December 31, 1985, June 30, 1986, September 30, 1986, December 31, 1986, June 30, 1987, September 30, 1987, December 31, 1987 and June 30, 1988. (SEC v. Encibar, Inc., Civil Action No. 87-2605, USDC DC). (LR-11935)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

QUILLIN PORTER INDICTED

The Fort Worth Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the Western District of Arkansas announced that on November 15 Quillin Porter, formerly of Fayetteville, Arkansas, was indicted on three counts of mail fraud and three counts of sales of unregistered securities.

The indictment charges that in connection with sales of capital stock in several investment clubs, Porter misrepresented to investors, among other things: (1) invested funds would be used to purchase marketable securities; (2) investors would receive a substantial monthly dividend on their investments; (3) profits were realized through Porter's management of invested funds; and (4) that the investment clubs were financially sound. The indictment further charges that Porter used investor funds to pay artificIally high dividends to early investors in order to attract additional investors.

If convicted, Porter faces a maximum jail term of 30 years, a \$45,000 fine, and restitution of up to \$5 million. (U.S. v. Quillin Porter, et al., Criminal Action 88-50014, USDC WDAR). (LR-11936)
